Suspended Bass Fishing

As a rule of thumb, the fishing community generally accepts that there are certain timeframes or conditional factors that make fishing flat-out tough. Post-frontal conditions, rising or falling water, dirty water, and early postspawn all can make some anglers cringe at the thought of hitting the water.

Any situation where bass are suspended can also intimidate a bass angler. When bass are floating around aimlessly in the water and willing to swim to an entirely different area code at the drop of a hat, it no doubt creates tough fishing. Largemouths, smallmouths and spotted bass are all guilty of it

from time to time, yet spots can be notorious for it.

West Coast pro Cody Meyer has grown up dealing with suspended spotted bass in clear water and has figured out how to handle this situation by perfecting an easy free-falling presentation.

As far as Meyer is concerned, his approach to catching suspended spotted bass – or any suspended bass, for that matter – can work whenever the situation arises, though he finds the late season to be prime.

"Really you can catch suspended fish year round because from postspawn to prespawn bass will suspend," says Meyer. "I honestly think the best time to chase big spotted bass that suspend is during the fall and winter.

"There are really three reasons why bass suspend: fishing pressure, rising or falling water, and bait. Bait is probably the biggest reason. Most bass in reservoirs feed on baitfish like blueback herring, smelt or small Kokanee salmon like we have out west. Bait like this doesn't relate to structure, so it makes sense that the bass that feed on them suspend in the water column like they do."

Locating suspended bass might seem like finding a needle in a haystack. And catching those fish when you can't see the target is also tough.

Meyer doesn't let that deter him, however, and relies on modern electronics to locate and catch fish.

"The first thing I do when I launch on a body of water and I know I'll try to target suspended spotted bass is find a bridge or a

bluff wall – some place that I can visually see and know holds bass throughout the year," Meyer explains. "From there I'll idle around those areas until I start to mark fish on my graph. Take note of what depth you are seeing fish because if the majority of the fish are hanging around 20 feet, then they generally will hang out at that depth across the lake."

From there you can run a variety of structure, including points, humps and deep breaks, scanning for bass at each stop.

So, what is Meyer's secret to fooling stubborn suspended bass into biting? Truth be told, it involves not doing much.

"Most people that target suspended fish and especially spotted bass like to slow-roll a swimbait or throw a jerkbait," Meyer notes. "And those work great at times, but one of my favorite things to do is cast out a small plastic on a jighead and let it slowly fall through the school of fish. I like to think of it as open-water punching with a small rig.

"To do this I generally have a target continue to the next page

in mind, like a bluff wall or tip of a point. I know what depth the fish are in because I graphed around a little before making a cast. So now all I do is cast the bait out as far as I can and let it naturally fall on a slack line through the school. It is such a simple presentation, but I can't tell you how many big fish I have caught doing it."

Meyer will make several casts throughout an area where he believes fish are suspended, counting down each time until he believes the bait has passed the fish.

If you can't stand to simply do nothing on the fall, Meyer suggest shaking the bait on a semi-slack line back to the boat. Done this way, he'll let it swing as it falls like a pendulum by lifting the rod tip up and reeling up the slack, pausing to let the bait fall while shaking it as it swings.

Meyer's tackle selection is also pretty straightforward. He prefers a 1/16- or 1/8-ounce Owner Ultrahead Darter Head matched with either a Strike King Dream Shot or Fat Baby Finesse Worm. Meyer says that the darter head is a great choice because it spirals down on the fall and mimicks a dying baitfish. He also keeps an Owner Ultrahead Round Jig Head rigged (in the same sizes with the same baits) for when the fish are looking for something with a subtler fall.

Meyer fishes with his signature 7-4 Daiwa Tatula Elite spinning rod paired with a Daiwa Tatula LT 2500 reel to launch the lightweight baits as far as he can. Interestingly, the most important part of the whole package for Meyer is the line.

"I love using hi-vis braid for my mainline, and I think it is the most critical part of the whole thing," he says. "I like 20-pound-or-less Seaguar Smackdown yellow braided line. Not only does it help cast the bait farther, it allows you to visibly see strikes since you are letting the bait fall on a slack line. I've seen it so many times with spotted bass where your line stops for a split second and then you set the hook and catch one. Without having yellow line, there'd be no way you could catch those fish."

"From personal experience I believe the bigger spotted bass suspend and barely get fished for, so you can have them all to yourself - especially in California," says Meyer. "I'm also a firm believer that the biggest spots live offshore their whole life. That's why this presentation can be so effective. Plus, it is super easy for almost anyone to do. It's how I caught my 10.8-pound giant last year."

Try this at your favorite lake.

Arizona Elk Brought In For Elk Stocking Plans

HOLDEN, W.Va. — Fifty-one elk completed their journey from Arizona and were released into a holding facility in Logan County earlier this month.

The elk, which are part of West

Virginia's elk restoration project, were captured in late January and held near Flagstaff, Arizona for disease testing. The elk arrived at the holding facility near Holden, West Virginia, late on March 4.

"It has been a wonderful experience working with the wildlife professionals in Arizona and all of the private supporters who are helping make West Virginia's elk restoration project possible," said DNR Director Stephen McDaniel.

This group of elk will join more

than three dozen elk previously brought in from Kentucky over the past two years. The Arizona elk will be quarantined until they are released onto the Tomblin Wildlife Management Area in Logan County, as directed by the United States Department of Agriculture.

Each elk is equipped with a Global Positioning System (GPS) radio transmitter to monitor its movements. All GPS transmitters were purchased and donated by the Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation.





Fishing For Bass On Sand Bars And Drops

One of the most successful fishermen Kentucky Lake has ever seen, Sam Lashlee makes a living guiding and teaching on the Tennessee River reservoir. From time to time, he also fishes a tournament or two, and when he does, it usually goes well. One of the key patterns that Lashlee relies on for the fall of the year is fishing main-lake bars, or drops, with a topwater. This is how he does it.

Find the right bottom

The biggest key to putting together a bar pattern is finding the right type of bar. For Lashlee, that starts with the bottom composition.

"The key to bar fishing to me is to make sure it has a hard bottom, whether it's gravel or whatever, and especially make sure it has shells on it," he says. Shells can be picked out on sonar when the water is higher in the summer, or you might simply see the telltale white dots from overturned and broken up shells on continue to page 15

a gravel bar if the water is clear enough.

"That's the start of the food chain on this lake," says Lashlee of shells. "After that, I like following those gizzard shad, and wherever the gizzard shad are is where the big largemouths are going to be." Location keys

Location is the next step, and Lashlee likes to stay on the main lake because of the current.

"I'm not going into the bays," says Lashlee. "A lot of people catch them in the bays, but personally I really don't do it unless the wind dictates that I have to. I like staying in a place where, if they do pull current, I'm going to be in the current."

Aside from staying away from the bays, he's not too picky on where the bar is located. It might be on the head or tail of an island or near a secondary channel. Lashlee says that, at times, he's fished in 2 or 3 feet of water with his boat in the main river in 30 feet.

Even so, in the fall particularly, it is almost impossible to go too shallow.

One additional plus of staying on the main lake is the wind. Lash-

lee says he's caught them on top in 3-footers, but his ideal wind is a light ripple, and that's nearly always present on the main lake.

When to fish the bars

For Lashlee, looking for big, tournament-winning bass up shallow is a year-round deal, but the sweet

spot is from late summer through the winter.

"I've won tournaments the first of June on ledges fishing in 1 to 3 feet of water. So I never rule it out," he says. "Last winter, I was catching fish out of 1 to 3 feet of water continue to the next page



So I never rule it out," he says. "Last winter, I was catching fish out of 1 to 3 feet of water in 42-degree water on a Red Eye Shad in the hydrilla.

"This year, I started fishing those bars in July, and they were there," explains Lashlee. "I had a 38-pound bag, and the water was 87 degrees about a month and a half ago [late September], and they were in a foot of water or less. I always believe they are there, and I usually can catch them there."

Though Lashlee looks to shallow bars earlier and longer than many, history on Kentucky Lake says that the bar pattern really shines in the fall, and is maybe at its peak from September on through October.

One adjustment that Lashlee makes as winter gets closer is that he begins to key a little on cover and not totally on bait.

"I have noticed that they will key on those stumps," says Lashlee. "When it [the water temperature] gets to the low 60s and the 50s, they will key on those stumps a lot more. But you don't need to have cover, just a hard bottom."

Lashlee says that since August, about 90 percent of his casts have been made with one bait: a Strike King Sexy Dawg.

The bait

Only if he knows fish have been in the area and they won't bite will Lashlee make a bait change.

"There are days that they don't want the Sexy Dawg, and I'll go to a Strike King KVD Splash," says Lashlee. "It's like a Pop-R type bait, but I like it better and it's a little bit bigger. There are days where they won't hit the Sexy Dawg for whatever reason, and I can go to that Splash and just barely move it and get them to eat."

Revoving Shed Elk Antlers Prohibited





Walking Baits For Bass Fishing

Walking topwaters are a staple for bass fishing, particularly in the summer and fall. Being a pro, Scott Canterbury is as expert in the ways of a walking bait as about anyone. Even if you're settled in your ways, the Quaker State pro's tips might help you put a few more in the boat.

Canterbury says he keeps a walk-

ing bait tied on for much of the year, but particularly likes one in the spring and the fall.

"In the spring, during the spawn or postspawn, I'll throw it around the spawning areas," says Canterbury. "If they're down there spawning or guarding fry that will get them to come up and show themselves. A lot of times they don't get the bait, but you can come back and catch them on something else."

In the fall, it's more about getting fish to eat than show themselves.

"In the fall it's about schooling fish," says Canterbury. "If fish are chasing bait or in open water, that's when I fish a walking bait. When you're not necessarily targeting cover as much as you are bait, that's when I fish it.

Of course, schooling fish can be notoriously frustrating, so Canterbury likes to have other options handy.

"If they don't hit it I go to a swimbait or a jerkbait," says Canterbury, "something that's down below the surface. Even though fish are schooling a lot in the fall, they're not necessarily coming up to get a bait, so much as chasing a bait up to the surface.

"In the fall around schooling fish, sometimes you have to walk it a little bit faster than you do in the spring. Every once in a while I'll change it up during a cast, and if one boils at it I'll maybe speed it up a bit like it's trying to get away,

but usually I stick with a steady cadence."

Tackle tips

Throwing a walking bait is like fishing any other topwater, in that you want it to stay at the surface, work well and land fish. Canterbury chooses his tackle accordingly.

"I've got to where I like braid, but you've got to have a real soft rod to throw it on braid," says Canterbury. "So I usually throw straight copolymer – 15-pound-test green P-Line CXX – with a 7-2, medium-action rod and a 7:1 high-speed reel anytime I'm throwing a walking bait."

ing baits on the market, and Canterbury isn't shy to say that he has used and still uses many of them. Per Canterbury, one of his favorites now is the Bagley Knocker B, a long-casting molded topwater that is easy to walk.

Canterbury likes that it comes with good hooks, but when he does need to change them he goes with standard round-bend trebles. According to Canterbury, a round bend is better than a wide-gap treble for "snagging" fish that just take a swipe at a bait.

Finally, the Alabama pro always removes the split ring and attaches the bait with a loop knot.

"A lot of baits come with a split ring, but it weighs a little bit and keeps the nose down," says Canterbury. "If you get the nose up a little bit it makes it easier to walk the bait back and forth."

Canterbury uses a simple overhand loop knot that works regardless of line type.



Fishing For Bass In High Muddy Water

In lieu of all the rain that has led to recent flooding conditions around the nation, you may be among those anglers trying to figure out how to deal with rising and, oftentimes, muddy water.

High water has impacted everyone from the Gulf States to here in Michigan, where the lakes are still ice covered. Many southern anglers are dealing with fish in a variety of stages, from late winter seasonal patterns to spawning conditions.

There is no doubt that finding the bass is hard to do when the water is rising. The fish inherently want to push shallow and spread out when the water level is moving upwards.

Just keep in mind that some of your best spring fishing days can occur when warming water is rising fast. Cold water makes it a little tougher, and I will get into that later.

I key on runoff areas, such as backs of creeks, around culverts or even residential yards and water from city streets. Water temperature is critical, as it can vary from one pocket or creek to another. You may find as much as a five-degree difference from one spot to the next, so look for the warmest runoff you can find.

And don't overlook ultra-shallow areas. Bass will put their noses on a seawall, bank or a log even if it's in inches of water.

I will fish a spinnerbait under those conditions most of the time. The spinnerbait usually fishes well in flooded grass, bushes and around trees and allows me to cover water faster and more thoroughly. However, spinnerbait style is critical. This is when I want a bulky spinnerbait with Colorado blades. Those blades not only put out a lot of vibration to help the fish find the bait in muddy water, but they provide lift and require you to wind

the bait slower. As a result, the bait will stay in the strike zone longer and make it easier for the fish to react.

I also opt for bright colors, such as fire tiger, chartreuse, fluorescent oranges, yellows and even pearl white. Black can be good too, because it provides a good silhouette in dirty water.

If there is too much debris to fish a spinnerbait, I will got to 1/2-ounce Strike King Hack Attack Flipping Jig in black/blue with a blue craw-colored Rage Craw (or a similar rig in white) and flip it into thick cover or even swim it, depending upon the area I'm fishing.

Now, in cold water, your challenge rises. It's the toughest to face in early spring.

Just remember that if the bass are still in the winter pattern, they are less likely to move to prespawn areas when the water is cold and rising. However, there always is a segment of the fish population that lives shallow most of the time, and that's where I like to throw a KVD 1.5 Flat crankbait that displaces a lot of water and allows me to make a lot of casts while searching for fish.

It's important to fish this lure close to the bottom or near objects

because that's where the fish will be holding. In cold muddy water, I will make parallel casts to channel swings, steeper banks, and riprap.

Rising water may wash out your favorite places to fish for spring bass, but that doesn't mean you can't catch them in other areas. Just employ some of the tactics outlined here, cover a lot of water and you might be surprised with the results.

And remember, it's all about the attitude!

Catfishing Tips

What's the best time to catch catfish?

Is one time of the year better as far as catching cats?

This is a question we're asked frequently by catfish anglers of all experience levels. It's normal to question if there's something you can do to increase your success by taking advantage of seasonal patterns.

As far as the best time to catch catfish, I'll give you a general summary of the different seasons and how it impacts the catfish action.



ver fifteen years as a professional catfish guide in Texas but the same information applies. The same general rules will apply everywhere across the United States but seasonal changes could happen earlier or later depending on climate.

Catfish behavior and patterns are all relative to water temperature because catfish don't have a calendar, water temperature controls everything.

I could write for hours and hours and fill multiple books with different patterns and catfishing techniques to use different times of the year so I'm going to cover the ba-

The short answer about the best time to catch catfish is that catfishing is good all year long in much of the country but you may be better off focusing your efforts on a specific species of catfish at times to increase your success.

pecially true of early season fishing where catching transition catfish can be frustrating especially for inexperienced anglers. Putting some time on the water in and learning to locate and pattern seasonal transition cats will teach you that the early spring transition offers some amazing fishing.

Anytime there's a drastic change in water temperature the fish scatter and become more difficult to pattern and when water temperatures stabilize then fishing patterns and catfish locations will become more consistent. They're always biting somewhere but during certain times it can be difficult to find that "somewhere".

As the weather warms and water

temperatures stabilize the catfishing action goes crazy. The warm water makes the cats much more active. They're hungry coming out

of a long winter where cold water makes them lethargic and they're not feeding heavily. This means them losing body weight during the winter and they're going to put that back on by feeding heavily.

Late March, April and early May is some of the best blue catfish fishing of the year for numbers of fish and also offers excellent opportunities for trophy class catfish as well.

Channel catfish action is typically excellent and very consistent also.

Flathead catfish are virtually inactive during the winter and the warm spring waters puts them in a feeding frenzy not only adding back the lost Winter weight but also getting ready for spawn.
