

New Campground In Beckley

BEAVER, W.Va. – Long in the works, a campground at Little Beaver State Park will open 30 of the planned 46 total campsites on July 1, just in time for the Independence Day holiday weekend. The 30 campsites will be first-come first-served. The location is minutes off I-64 in Raleigh County. From I-64, take Exit 129A, It is two miles south on WV 307.

"It will quickly become one of our most successful campgrounds in our state park system," said Ken Caplinger, chief of West Virginia State Parks. "It is a welcome addition to our outdoor recreation offerings at state parks."

"These 30 sites have water and electricity," said Erik Evans, park superintendent. "The remaining 16 sites, when completed, will have water only. All sites currently

have gravel based pads and access and can accommodate up to a 40foot RV. The campground features a central dump station, check-in building with camp store. The camp store offers wireless Internet."

A large bathhouse with laundry facilities is also open. "As we bring the campground into full operation, I know campers will appreciate the on-site services and amenities," said Evans. The remaining 16-sites are forecast to be open by mid- to late-fall in 2011. Site paving is planned.

Camping rates are \$28 for sites with water and electricity and \$25 for sites with water hookup only. "Although these first sites are first-come first-serve for now, we expect to begin taking reservations next year. Our system will mirror the state park campground reservation guidelines," Evans said.

Until now, Little Beaver State Park has been a popular 562-acre day use park featuring Little Beaver Lake for fishing, paddle and row boating. The five reservable picnic shelters, playground, geocaching, activity building and game room are popular with families, reunions and day visitors. Fishing Tips

When's the best time to fish for walleve?

Close to night time as walleye are

nocturnal. As the sun goes down walleye will come up out of the deep and start to feed. This is the best time to catch them using body baits that run only 10-15 ft down. What approaches should be taken when fishing a new lake for bass? Look at maps on a fish finder to see the contours and deeps along with the structure and cover. Bass love cover (rocks, weedbeds, shipwrecks, etc) so it is very important to know where these are on your GPS. If GPS is not available, paper maps can still give you the contours and lay of the lake. The next approach is to talk to the locals, like at tackle shops, for tips on what fish have been biting on and what methods have been most effective recently.

What are some effective carp fishing techniques?

Chumming the water beforehand with canned corn or bread will help attract carp to the area. Just be sure it is legal in your state or province: check the regulations for your area. As for bait, a common setup is a hair rig for carp. With the hair rig you will want the fish to run with the bait so keep your reel open so the fish can take line and swim

Sturgeon are bottom feeders, like carp and catfish. They love high protein foods like worms, scrimps, and fish. Unlike catfish and carp,

What are the best depths when fishing for largemouth bass?

Largemouths are usually shallow water fish but will go deep depending on the temperatures and feeding patterns. In the shallower water use your top water lures over structure like logs and rocks. Topwater lures will call out bass from hiding areas. You can fish deeper water with a tube jig by working it off the bottom, but not too deep. Largemouth are generally caught at depths no greater than 20 feet, and often in much shallower depths than that.

What are some tips for catching a walleye through the ice?

Try deeper water for Walleye. They like areas that are weedy. Walleye will move throughout the day so you may need to move with them. Heavy traffic from other ice fishermen (snowmobiles and atv's) may scare them so try a spot that has good weed growth and away from the heavy traffic of other anglers. Using a jig tipped with a minnow is most effective. Remember not to over-jig as walleye can be quite lethargic in colder seasons.

What are some effective catfish techniques?

Smell is important when fishing for catfish, so the stinkier the better. Like carp, a hair rig (where the bait is on the line and the hook away from the bait) is a useful setup for

catfish. If you do put your bait on the hook make sure it is strong but not too big. Ball the bait on it so the hook is hidden. Worms are an effective bait for catfish. Target under cuts on the edges of banks and log jams. Be sure to use strong braided line to get the catfish out of heavy cover.

What temperature do trout usually feed at?

Trout are very temperature sensitive. The ideal temperature is anywhere between 54F to 64F. Trout will feed heavily at this time. If the temperature rises the fish will seek the coolest water it can and usually not feed. If the temperature is low the fish's metabolism slows and they seek out the pools in the river and will feed, but only if the feed is right in front of them.

Where do I fish for muskie?

Muskie can occupy any depth of the water column depending upon their size and feeding habits; Smaller muskies usually inhabit the same locations as Bass and Walleye (weedlines, thick cover, and submerged wood); bigger, more mature muskies are usually near deeper water haunts and feed on some of the lakes higher protein baitfish like smelts, herring or

suckers. Trolling or casting bigger baits near off shore humps, shoals, or drop offs can produce bigger fish.

What do I use to fish for bass in the middle of summer?

The key thing is to be versatile as what will entice a bass one day may not the next. First off, some form of topwater bait works well, fishing off of key locations like points or shoals with deep water close by for either largies and/or smallies. As the day progresses, switch presentations and bait selections, depending on the species of bass. If it's a largemouth bass lake, choose some form of semi-weedless bait that can be fished in or around heavy weed growth, like a texas-rigged worm or crawfish imitation. It's a good idea to have several rods rigged up with different baits as you'll be able to switch baits and presentations more easily until you find a

successful pattern.

Fishing Techniques

Bait Casting

Bait casting is a style of fishing that relies on the weight of the lure to extend the line into the target area. Bait casting involves a revolving-spool fishing reel (or "free spool") mounted on the topside of the rod. Bait casting is definitely an acquired skill. Once you get the hang of the technique (check out the casting animation), you will be casting your lures right on target into the structures where fish are feeding and hanging out.

With bait casting, you can use larger lures (1/2 to 3/4) and cast them for longer distances. To get started, you'll need a rod with good spring action, a good quality anti-backlash reel, 10 to 15 pound test line and a variety of specific bait casting lures.

Spin Casting

We won't say it's foolproof, but spin casting is an ideal fishing method for beginning anglers. Spin-casting equipment is easier to use than bait casting. You can use it to cast both light and heavy lures without tangling or breaking your fishing line. Basic equipment includes a 7-foot rod, a spinning reel and 6 to 10 pound test line for casting 1/16 to 3/4 ounce lures. You can use an open-face, closed-face or spin-cast reel for spin casting.

Trolling

Trolling is done using a small electric motor that moves the boat quietly through the water so fish aren't spooked. But you can also troll by towing a lure while walking along the edge of a shoreline, bridge or pier. The speed of the boat detercontinue to the next page

mines the depth of your bait. And the depth of the bait is determined by the species of fish you're trying to catch. Use a spinning reel or a bait caster for trolling. Some states don't allow motorized trolling, so check out your local fishing regulations to avoid tangling with the fish enforcers.

Still Fishing

Still fishing is a versatile way to go. You can still fish from a pier, a bridge, an anchored boat or from shore. You can still fish on the bottom or off the bottom in ponds, lakes, rivers and streams for a variety of species. And you can still fish during most seasons and during any part of the day. Your equipment and the size of the hooks and bait you use depends on what kind of fish you're after. But your best equipment for still fishing is patience. You have to wait for the fish to bite.

Drift Fishing

Drift fishing allows you to fish over a variety of habitats as your boat drifts with the currents or wind movement. You can drift fish on the bottom or change the depth with a bobber or float. Natural baits work best. But jigs, lures and artificial flies will produce good results, too.

You can drift fish on ponds, lakes, rivers and streams any time of the day and year.

Live Lining

Your fishing line is "live" when your boat is anchored in a flowing body of water like a river or stream. Use live or prepared fishing bait and keep it on or just off the bottom. Live lining off the bottom allows

your line to drift with the current through holes and rocks where the fish may be holding. Your equipment and the size of your fishing hooks and lures depend on what type of fish you're after.

Chumming

To attract fish or get them biting again, you can throw "chum" into

the water where you're fishing. You can use ground-up bait fish, canned sweet corn, dead minnows in a coffee can for ice fishing, pet food, even breakfast cereal. Or stir up some natural chum by scraping the bottom with a boat oar. Be sure not to over-chum. You want to get them interested in feeding; you do not want to stuff them before they get a chance to go after your hook. Chumming is not legal in all states. Check local fishing fishing regulations to make sure you are not illegally stimulating the hunger of your future catch.

Bottom Bouncing

4 Ponds

Bottom Bouncing is done from a drifting or trolling boat, and it's a great way to attract or locate fish during most seasons and times of day. Use a buck tail jig or natural bait and drag it along the bottom. The dragging motion causes the lure to bounce along stirring up small clouds of sand or mud. After a few strikes with bottom bouncing, you can drop anchor and apply other methods to hook the particular kind of species you've attracted. Surface Poppers

There's nothing quite like the sudden, exciting rush of a fish rising to the surface and exploding onto your lure. Surface poppers are a style of topwater fishing bait that get their action from a cupped face carved or molded into the front of the lure body. Cast your popper out to the target area and let it settle briefly. By taking in small amounts of line slowly, the cupped face "pops" along the surface, imitating the action of prey, such as small insects, small frogs or even a small injured fish. Jigging

Jig fishing is popular and challenging. Why? Because the person fishing is creating the action that attracts, or doesn't attract, the particular type of fish he or she is trying to catch. Here's how it works. Cast out and let your jig hook sink to the bottom. Then use your rod tip to raise the bait about a foot off the bottom. Then let it drop back to the bottom. You can jig up and down, side to side or up and down and sideways. Jig rigs come in all sizes, shapes and colors, and can be used with or without live fishing bait.



Jig and Worm

Attach a worm to your jig hook and use it to bottom hop or sweep through your target area. To bottom hop, cast to the target and let the jig sink. Then reel in slowly, twitching the rod with every third or fourth turn of your reel. To sweep, cast to the target and drag the jig parallel to the bottom while reeling with a fairly tight line. Slow and steady gets the fish when you're sweeping with a jig and worm.



Kennedy's Continuing Education

Before the Toyota Toyota Trucks All-Star Week voting started, Steve Kennedy was asked who he would like to see the fans vote into the tournament. The first name he mentioned was Aaron Martens.

"I think Aaron Martens could teach us something about how to catch those Coosa River bass," Kennedy said. "I learn more from Aaron Martens than anyone on the tour."

That statement exemplifies how much emphasis Kennedy places on continuing education in the world of bass fishing. To some, it might seem self-destructive to want another angler with more knowledge than you in the event. But Kennedy takes the long view. Anything he learns from Martens during All-Star Week might pay off in another tournament somewhere down the road.


As the son of a former Bassmaster Classic competitor – Van Kennedy – Steve Kennedy got more home schooling than most anglers. So the tips that some might have learned in a bass fishing seminar were most often old hat to the Auburn, Ala., angler.

"I've been to one seminar in my

life where I actually learned something that really, really impressed me," Kennedy said. "David Fritts came down to Georgia one time and gave a seminar. And it wasn't like your typical seminar. We went into a classroom setting, and he sat down with everyone and said, 'What do you want to know?'

"Someone asked him what his favorite color crankbait was, and he said, 'Chartreuse with a brown back.' He had won a couple of those Red Man regionals on Lake Sinclair.

"So I went out and custom-painted some crankbaits."



So how did they work?

Kennedy looks you in the eyes, then looks away while adjusting the Auburn Tigers cap that usually sits atop his head. It's a sign that Kennedy would just as soon not continue to the next page

answer that question. But he eventually does.

"It's pretty amazing," Kennedy said. "That's basically why I'm sitting here today, that one thing I got out of Fritts."

And that, bass anglers, is a bold statement. Kennedy has won over \$1 million on the B.A.S.S. circuit and another \$650,000 in FLW events. His B.A.S.S. record includes two first-place finishes, two seconds, five thirds and 20 top 10s. Kennedy finished fifth in the Bassmaster Elite Series Toyota Tundra Angler of the Year race this season.

Kennedy had another important influence in his youth, this one far more unlikely than his bass fishing father.

"My grandmother was a pretty good painter," Kennedy said. "She made me take all those art classes growing up as a kid. I won't say I hated it, but Grandma made me do it, Mom made me do it, it was one

of those things."

After Kennedy heard Fritts' comment about crankbait colors in 1996, he put those childhood art lessons in practice, bought an airbrush painting kit and began custom painting lures.

"It's pretty neat to have a creative outlet at this point," said Kennedy, who has a mechanical engineering degree from Auburn. "As an engineer, being creative is a big part of it

"There are very few baits that I fish stock – very, very, very few. I carry an airbrush with paints, and I've had some real good tournaments because of it."

The 2008 Bassmaster Elite Series schedule provides a good example. There were back-to-back tournaments in May on lakes where blueback herring are the dominant bass forage. Kenyon Hill won the first one at Clarks Hill in Georgia, where the Sebile Magic Swimmer swimbait emerged as a good blue-

back herring imitation.

Because of that name, blueback herring lures often have a blue tint on the back. But the baitfish actually has a green-gray tint, not blue. So Kennedy went swimbait shopcontinue to the next page

ping after the Clarks Hill tournament, came to South Carolina's Lake Murray two weeks later and got out the airbrush kit.

"I custom painted those Sebiles after I saw what color the bait was," Kennedy said. "I didn't even know about that swimbait until Kenyon won over at Clarks Hill. I got a few to practice with at Murray, and in a matter of three or four days I had them custom painted and almost won."

Kennedy finished second to Fred Roumbanis at Murray and earned a check for \$42,000.

Kennedy looks at every lure with the eye of an artist, not just the hard bodies, like crankbaits and some swimbaits.

"Most of the time when you're fishing a frog, you aren't imitating a frog," Kennedy said. "You're imitating a bluegill."

That white belly on most soft plastic frogs gives Kennedy a clean slate to apply his art skills.

"Frogs dye very well with an airbrush," Kennedy laughed.

That's just one final example of how Kennedy spots a bass fishing trend, thinks about it, then allows his creativity to go to work.

Dehydration Scare For Angler

Matt Herren has survived a "drinking problem." And he wants you to know about it, so you don't have to live through the nightmare he did.

Herren's health concern would be more accurately described as a "lack of drinking problem." Competition in three straight bass fishing tournaments – all of which were endured under sweltering heat – put the 48-year-old Trussville, Ala., angler in a world of hurt. It resulted in him undergoing a battery of health tests this week. Ultimately, Herren was hooked to an I.V. to replace the fluids he lost.

"I almost pushed it past the limit," Herren said. "We all think we're invincible. It almost got me."

Herren is an outdoorsman. Besides bass fishing, which he does for a living, Herren's other hobbies are hunting and golf. He has never been bothered by extreme temperatures, either heat or cold. So when he came down with extreme chills, nausea, an aching body and a headache while competing in an FLW event on the Potomac River, he thought he'd picked up a virus of some kind or possibly food poison-

ing.

"All of us get those 24-hour-bugs," Herren said. "You just fight through it and go on."

Herren stays in his camper when traveling for bass tournaments. He said he usually turns the air conditioner on its coldest setting when he goes to sleep at night. But he couldn't do that during the Potomac River tournament.

"I had a bout of severe chills," continue to the next page

Herren said. "I was shaking while I was lying under every blanket I could find."

It was a phone call to his daughter-in-law – a pharmacist – that first alerted him to the idea that he might be suffering from dehydration. After that, Herren made certain he was drinking extra fluids while competing on the Potomac, where he picked up an \$11,000 check for a 29th-place performance.

Those winnings, however, weren't enough to make him feel any better when he got to Little Rock the following week for the Bassmaster Elite Series Diamond Drive. He practiced only about a day-and-ahalf, venturing out only for earlymorning and late-afternoon sessions on the Arkansas River. He finished 92ndin the 99-man field. And he wasn't feeling any better when he drove to Decatur, Ala., for the final Elite Series event of the regular season.

Once again, Herren fought through the pain and extreme fatigue. He made the two-day cut in the top 50. Then he earned another \$10,000

with a 16th-place finish last Saturday on Wheeler Lake.

By this time, suspecting dehydration was the cause of his discomfort, Herron was drinking all the extra liquids he could get his hands on. But nothing was alleviating his symptoms of nausea, body aches and headaches. So when Herron got home after the Dixie Duel at Wheeler, he went to see his doctor. Lab work confirmed that Herren was suffering from severe dehydration. He was promptly injected with intravenous fluids.

"My electrolytes and my blood sugar were really messed up," Herren said. "It had started affecting my kidneys. I got too far down to where I couldn't drink enough fluids to catch up. Once you get past that point, you're in trouble. I had been dehydrated to a dangerous level for three weeks."

Herren was feeling much better this week after the I.V. In fact, he was feeling good enough for a round of golf on Wednesday.

"It was cloudy and only about 85 degrees," Herren said. "I rode in a cart: I didn't walk."

Don't let that round of golf fool you. Herren has been appropriately scared by his bout with dehydration. His advice for others includes familiarizing yourself with the symptoms. For instance, Herren continue to the next page

kept sweating profusely during those three weeks of tournament fishing. He had mistakenly thought the body shutdown the perspiration process during dehydration.

"I just didn't understand the symptoms," Herren said.

Now that he does, Herren said he will be concentrate on drinking extra fluids days before an event where heat will be a concern, not just on those hot days of competition. And at the first sign of dehydration, he won't hesitate to get himself to an emergency room.

"I should have gone to the doctor immediately," Herren said. "But I was being hard-headed about it. If something like that happens again, I'll go straight to the E.R. and tell them to get some fluids in me."

Herren has qualified for the past three Bassmaster Classics, but he didn't qualify for the 2012 Classic through the Elite Series schedule this year. So Herren considered competing in the first Bassmaster Northern Open, scheduled for July 7-9 on the James River at Richmond, Va. After looking at the

weather forecast, Herren decided against it.

"Temperatures are supposed to be around 100 degrees," Herren said. "I've learned my lesson."



do that."

Grigsby opened the tournament in 10th place Thursday with five bass weighing 19-11. On Friday he added another five bass weighing 14-10 to move up to seventh place. He then caught five bass weighing 16-1 Saturday to make the crucial top-10 cut in third place.

Grigsby said he fished spots around the Paris area as well as around Moors Resort and Marina on Kentucky Lake. The Paris area consisted of a channel swing that



featured turns in it. Grigsby said he targeted bass in 19 to 21 feet of water in that area with a worm on a jighead. Grigsby said he started the first two days of competition there to catch a quick limit and then ran north in search of bigger fish.

Grigsby said he caught about eight keepers Sunday; his key area was near a creek in front of Moors.

"There's a ditch that goes through it and then drops back to 15 or 16 feet," Grigsby said. "And the top where the ditch comes back up is where the big shell bed is. That's where I caught every one of them.

"Everybody was talking about catching 50 and 60 (fish) and whatever, but I didn't get in on that," Grigsby added. "If I caught a bunch of little ones I wouldn't stay, because I've found if you catch a bunch of little ones you don't usually catch very many big ones. So if I caught one 3 (pounds) or better, that would be the area I would focus on."

Grigsby's setup for the week included a 3/4-ounce Secret Lures football-head jig as well as a jighead with a homemade worm on it. Grigsby also employed the use

New Trail At Stonewall Resort

ROANOKE, W.Va. – A newly-constructed hiking trail will open soon at Stonewall Resort State Park in Lewis County. The "Cairns Trail" (pronounced karens) is a three-mile hiking and biking trail that meanders through a remote area of Stonewall Resort and connects two existing trails: the Heveners Trail and the Autumn Laurel Brooke

Trail. Park Supt. Sam England has been involved the creation of the trail to make it easier for guests to explore the cairns in the northern section of the park.

"The area is one of the better locations for seeing the diversity of the stoneworks that some believe to be American Indian artifacts," England said. "The trail passes through several cairn fields and along a rock formation referred to as a standing stone. We often call it the enigmatic rock. The large flat-faced stone is a true puzzle. How it can have the distinctive shape, location, and markings creates interesting discussions."

The Cairn Trail development, construction and associated work was funded by a recreational trails program grant with more than \$66,000 provided by the West Virginia Department of Transportation, Division of Highways and the Federal Highways Administration through the Recreational Trails Program. More than \$16,000 in matching
