

Duck Shooting Stations

POINT PLEASANT, W.Va. - Waterfowl hunters who wish to hunt from a shooting station in the controlled waterfowl hunting zone of McClintic Wildlife Management Area (WMA), located near Point Pleasant, must submit their applications by September 9, 2011, according to David T. McClung, Wildlife Manager for the Division of Natural Resources Wildlife Resources Section.

Hunting is by permit only on a portion of McClintic WMA during the October split of waterfowl season. Hunters are assigned an area free of charge, and are allowed to bring one guest. An accessible blind is available to the handicapped waterfowl hunter. Applicants are selected randomly by drawing and will be notified if selected. Hunters may apply by visiting the DNR website www.wvdnr.gov under "Hunting/Main Page" or by printing the following information on

a postcard: name; address; telephone number; and the day(s) they desire to hunt. Cards should be addressed to: DUCK BLINDS, 1163 Wildlife Road, Point Pleasant, WV 25550.

The controlled waterfowl hunt is Oct. 1 through Oct. 8, 2011. Applicants not selected may come to the McClintic WMA office on the morning of each day's hunt to apply for a shooting station left vacant by selected hunters who do not show up. These vacancies are filled on a first come basis. Those individuals not selected for an area may hunt waterfowl on McClintic WMA outside the controlled hunting zone. Consult the 2011-2012 West Virginia Migratory Bird Hunting Regulations for more complete information. Migratory bird regulations will be available at DNR offices by the end of August and are on the DNR's website now.



HUNTING SEASON IS HERE!

Shooting Range Damage Concerns

SOUTH CHARLESTON, W.Va. -Officials with the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources (DNR) are asking users of the state's public shooting ranges to help curtail growing instances of damage to the property. Of biggest concern are littering and gunfire damage to target frames, trash barrels, bench posts and other structures at the ranges.

DNR maintains nearly 30 public shooting ranges at numerous wildlife management areas, two state forests and other publicly accessible locations across West Virginia. These ranges were built and are maintained using funds from the sale of hunting licenses and conservation stamps. They are popular with hunters who use them to practice and sight in their firearms

prior to the state's various hunting seasons. Although hunters pay the costs of the ranges with their license fees, these facilities are open at no charge to the public and are becoming more popular with recreational shooters.

Recent months have shown an increase in shooting range users damaging the facilities with highpowered firearms and ammunition for which the ranges are not designed, and bringing in inappropriate items which are not permitted under wildlife management area regulations such as household appliances, computer monitors, glass bottles, etc. Some shooters have been using these items as targets



The result is that DNR's wildlife managers are spending much of their time repairing the ranges and removing trash instead of maintaining and creating hunting and fishing opportunities, according to DNR Director Frank Jezioro. Shooters are reminded that current regulations prohibit the use of glass or metal containers as targets on any public shooting range. Only paper, clay and metal silhouette targets may be used on these ranges.

"Many of the recreational shooters do not have West Virginia hunting licenses, so they do not contribute to the upkeep of the facilities," Jezioro said. "We're asking that shooters take out what they bring in to the range, and that anyone who sees shooters abusing the shooting ranges report it to their local Natural Resources Police Officer."

Jezioro said shooting range operations will continue as they are now and they will remain open to the public at no charge. However, shooting range users are urged to read and obey the posted rules so that the facilities remain in good continue to the next page



Wild Food Weekend

CAIRO, W.Va. – The 44th Annual Nature Wonder Wild Foods Weekend is scheduled at North Bend State Park September 16-18. Nature Wonder Weekend began in 1968 with author and wild foods enthusiast Euell Gibbons as the guest naturalist. Gibbons may be best remembered for a Post Grape Nuts advertisement and the phrase "Ever eat a pine tree? Many parts are edible."

"It is at North Bend State Park where Gibbons made it okay to use and know about 'foods from the land'," according to Edelene Wood. For 44 years, attendees of Nature Wonder Weekend have gathered from across the country to stalk wild foods. "Back-to-nature is popular again," Wood said.

Nature Wonder is a weekend package that includes activities,

lodging, meals – including a 'wild' one, – hikes and presentations. "Individuals with wild food or outdoor experiences influenced by Gibbons are asked to submit a written letter," said Wood. Letters submitted will become part of the Mugar Memorial Library of Boston University where Gibbons' personal papers are stored. His book, Stalking the Wild Asparagus, and others are still popular. Gibbons died in 1975.

The National Wild Foods Association emerged as a result this event. Association President Edelene Wood has carried on Gibbons work along with others who share this interest. "They laughed about Euell Gibbons and his 'wild food' in the early years," Wood recalled.

Gibbons advocated use of nutritious plants often overlooked. His gourmet approach to odd or unusual food deemed "wild" has again become a popular focus for television shows such as the Travel Channel's Bizarre Food and No Reservations.

Fishing Safety

Fishing isn't a dangerous sport, but you should prepare to be safe and comfortable in the outdoors. It is possible to get caught unexpectedly in bad weather, encounter insects, spend too much time in the sun, or get caught on a fish hook. Wearing the proper clothing helps to protect you from injury. It also

to protect you from injury. It also keeps you warm in cold weather and cool in hot weather. Rainwear and other gear keep you from getting wet and chilled.

Safety Around Water

Anglers should learn how to swim and use caution around water at all times. You should always use the "buddy system" and have a friend or an adult with you in case something goes wrong.

Personal Flotation Devices (PFDs) Buckle-up, Even While You Fish

Find out about BoatUS Foundation's Life Jacket Loaner Program Personal Flotation Devices (PFDs),

also called life jackets and life vests, are not just for wearing in boats. Anytime you are on or around deep or fast moving water, you should wear a PFD. U.S. Coast Guard and/ or state laws require you to have an approved PFD when you are in a boat, and that a boat must carry one PFD for each passenger on board. Certain types of boats must also have a cushion or ring that can be thrown to a person in the water. Wading

follow for safe wading.

- 1. Always wade with another person.
- 2. Always wear your PFD.
- 3. Know how deep the water is.
- 4. Know how strong the current is.
- 5. Know what the bottom is like by checking with a stick or staff. Shuffle your feet along the bottom to avoid holes.

While wading you can protect your ankles by wearing high-top shoes or wading boots. Long, lightweight pants can protect you from jellyfish and sea nettles in saltwater and from snags and rocks in freshwater.

Reach-Throw-Row-Go

Reach-throw-row-go is a method of rescuing a person who falls overboard or an angler or swimmer in trouble.

The first safety step is to REACH out with an oar, tree limb or other long object if the person is close to you. If you can't reach the person, THROW them a life-saving device. This can be a boat cushion or ring. Tie it to the end of a line so that it helps you pull the person to safety.

If a cushion or ring isn't available,

throw in anything that floats: plastic coolers, ski belts or even beach balls can be used in an emergency.

If there is nothing to throw, ROW a boat to the person in trouble. Ideally, take someone else with you

to help pull the person out of the water. The person should be pulled in over the stern, or back, of the boat. If the boat has a motor, shut it off before you attempt any water rescue. Don't let the person try to climb in over the side of a small boat, it can tip the boat over. Instead, pull the victim over the stern, or back, of the boat. If the boat is small, you can also have the victim hang onto the gunwales, and tow him to shore.

Swim out to save the person in trouble ONLY as a last resort and ONLY if you are an experienced lifeguard or have had life-saving training. Going into the water after someone is in trouble is dangerous. People who are drowning often panic and injure or even drown someone trying to rescue them. Going quickly for help is often the best choice.

Swimming

If you fish, you should know how to swim for your own safety. Many young anglers like to go for a swim during a fishing trip just for fun or to cool off. Don't swim if there is any doubt about your ability. Never dive into the water of an unknown area and don't swim in cold water or after a heavy meal. Finally swim only when an experienced swimming partner is with you.

Safety with Fishing Equipment Handle your fishing equipment responsibly. Look behind you before you cast to make sure your hook will not get caught on a power line, tree or person. To avoid accidents, don't leave your tackle lying on the ground. Someone can trip on it, step on a hook or break your equipment.

Have an enjoyable experience on the water. Fish safely.

Fishing Glossary

Bait

Natural attractant added to a hooks to catch fish. bait includes live and dead baitfish, crabs, crayfish, worms, eels, insects, mussels, clams, cut bait (fish), chicken livers, corn kernels, dough balls, squid, and shrimp.

Blade Bait

A weighted, fish-shaped blade made with a swinging hook and designed for fishing deep.

Buzz Bait

These "safety pin" wire lures for surface fishing have a propeller blade on one wire and a weighted body, skirt and hook on the other. Casting Spoon

A spoon-shaped metal or hard plastic lure that wobbles to attract fish. They can be fitted with a fixed (solid) hook or swinging hook, that has a single, double or treble points.

Chumming

A fishing technique by which bait or scent is released into the water to attract fish to take a lure or baited hook. Chum consists of live, dead, ground-up or prepared baits and scents and is used in fresh and saltwater.

Crank Bait

A fish-like hard lure or plug designed to swim under the surface, often made of plastic or wood. Some are combined

Float

Also called a "bobber", these suspend hooked bait off of the bottom, and signal hits by "bobbing" when a fish takes the bait.

Hook

A metal wire device shaped like a "J" with an opening or "eye" at one end to which the line is tied and a point at the other end to catch the fish. Circle hooks have an angled point. Double and treble hooks have two or three points, respectively.

Jig

Sometimes called "bucktails", these weighted-body (often lead) lures are molded on special hooks and rigged with a hair tail or soft plastic skirt or worm.

A method of dropping a lure into the water over a fishing site and moving it - "jigging it" - up and down to attract fish. Done from a pier or boat.

Leader

A length of monofilament, wire or other stranded material tied between the end of the line and the lure or hook. Leaders provide extra strength or abrasion resistance from the rough mouth and teeth of fish (pike, barracuda, sharks), scales (sharks), gill covers (tarpon and snook), blows from tails (tuna).

Line

Specialized "string" used for fishing. Nylon monofilament line is the most popular. Other lines are made of different materials, including braided fibers and wire. FLY LINE is a specialized line made of a plastic coating on a core, and

often made tapered (changing diameter) to make fly casting easier. (To preserve good fishing, take any discarded line with you when you leave. Discarded line can snag and harm wildlife, and kill fish, turtles, frogs, birds and small mammals.)

Any artificial item designed to attract fish and fitted with hooks. These include flies, hard plastic or wood lures (or plugs), soft plastic imitations, large offshore skirted baits, metal spoons, lead-head lures (jigs), bladed lures, spinners, spinnerbaits.

Reel

A mechanical device for holding and spooling fishing line. Reels have a line spool, brake to slow running fish, handle to retrieve line and foot for clamping to a rod. Reel styles include CASTING (revolving

spool), SPINNING (line coiling off stationary spool); SPINCAST, (like spinning but with a nose cone), and FLY (storing thick fly line/backing and to fight big fish).

Rod

A long lever, usually made of fiberglass, graphite or composite materials and used to catch fish. Different types are available, such as rods for spinning, fly fishing, spincast, bait casting, boat fishing offshore trolling, surf fishing, jetty/pier fishing, etc. Most rods have a reel-holding clamp and guides through which the line runs.

Sinker

A weight of lead or other metals designed to sink a hooked bait or lure.

Snap

A small device similar to a dog leash snap, tied to the line.

September Camping At State Parks

SOUTH CHARLESTON, W.Va. – Camping in September is cooler than during the hot summer months, and West Virginia State Parks are making it even more attractive by offering half-off discounts at participating campgrounds.

"When school starts, the camping season mellows, but just a little," according to Jon Teets, superintendent at Audra State Park in Barbour County. "Audra is hoppin' in the summertime, particularly on weekends. In September we find the pace a little slower and that's when park superintendents get creative and offer rate reductions to encourage campers to visit." Audra State Park campground is all first-come, first-served sites and is open from April 15 to mid-October.

"When the kids are back in school, camping decreases and the need for reservations also vanishes," according to Scott Durham, superintendent at Twin Falls Resort State Park in Wyoming County. "It would be a record day to have all 50 sites at Twin Falls full in September, so there's no waiting."

Several parks, including Twin Falls, reduce campsite fees from Sept. 6-30 by 50 percent. State parks and forests offer two September campsite rate reductions: areas that are Sunday-Thursday only and areas for any two consecutive days.

Sunday through Thursday – Eight parks extend the 50 percent off camping rates for Sunday through Thursday nights only with a minimum two night stay. "These areas are still heavily used in September and weekends are still like summertime – busy," said Brad Reed, district administrator with West Vir-





and Tygart Lake (Taylor County) state parks, and Kumbrabow State Forest (Randolph County).

Two consecutive days – Parks and forests offering 50 percent off campsite fees any two or more days from Sept. 6-30, 2011, include Plum Orchard (Fayette County) and Bluestone (Summers) wildlife management areas, Kanawha (Kanawha County), Greenbrier (Greenbrier County) and Cabwaylingo (Wayne County) state forests, Holly River (Webster County), Audra (Barbour/Upshur counties), Twin Falls (Wyoming County), and Moncove Lake (Monroe County) state parks.

"Campers will see foliage begin the color change in mid-September at some parks. If autumn color is early, it's an added bonus at Canaan Valley and Blackwater Falls, two parks that recognize the mid-week September rate," Reed advised.

"Campgrounds operated by the state park system are all first-come, first-served after Labor Day," Reed said. Reservable sites are available from Memorial – Labor Day weekends at West Virginia's state parks. the state where wildlife biologists have determined that limited numbers of antlerless deer permits are necessary to meet management objectives.

Five wildlife management areas (Bluestone, Elk River, Stonecoal, Stonewall Jackson Lake, and Teter Creek Lake) and public lands in two counties (Grant and Tucker) will have a limited number of Class N licenses for West Virginia residents to hunt antlerless deer from Nov. 23 through Dec. 10 and Dec. 28 through Dec. 31.

Applications must be received by the DNR before the close of business on Aug. 19, 2011.

The 2011 limited resident antlerless deer season will provide an opportunity for 1,010 residents to participate on the five WMAs. An additional 250 residents will be selected to hunt antlerless deer on public land in the two counties (Grant and Tucker) that are restricted to resident hunters.

forest foundation to support forest activities.

About Margaret L. Dension

Margaret Denison taught science and botany in Kanawha County schools for a number of years and was well known in the forest community. From the beginning of the Spring Walk, she was one of the most knowledgeable and dependable leaders. Davis Creek was her favorite trail and she always had a large following. She did not concentrate on botanical terminology but rather on the flora including ferns, grasses and sedges. These were identified by their common names and origins and further elaborated with delightful folklore. Margaret was a Life Member of the Kanawha State Forest Foundation and a generous monetary donor to Forest projects.

Margaret spent countless hours in the 1960s identifying and cataloging the flora of Kanawha State Forest in collaboration with Superintendent Osbra Eye. They compiled the booklet, "Flowering Plants of Kanawha State Forest," published in 1967.

In 1975, she received an award from the West Virginia Department of Natural Resources for the listing of 710 flowering plants, 42 ferns and their allies, and 138 grasses and sedges in the Forest. Margaret suffered a debilitating stroke in 2002 and moved to Arizona to be near her family. Sadly, she died on January 2, 2003. As a tribute to Margaret, in recognition of her outstanding contribution to the Forest and the Foundation, the Fall Nature Walks were renamed in 2003 in her honor.

Set In The Hook

Setting The Hook

When you get right down to it, you have to be able to set the hook in order to catch fish. It takes time and practice. It also takes patience. In a given situation, several factors may affect how you go about setting the hook – like fish species, the mood of the fish on a particular day, and your bait presentation. But here are some of the basics.

Get to know the species you're targeting – is it aggressive or more cautious? Is it a soft-mouthed species (such as crappie, shad, sea trout) or hard-mouthed (such as pike, musky, yellowfin tuna)? This will determine how hard you need to set the hook.

Stand in a stable position for balance and stability – knees slightly bent, legs roughly shoulder-width apart. Be relaxed but ready to react.

A good rule of thumb is to wait and feel the weight of the fish before setting the hook.

When targeting aggressive fish, set the hook hard and fast.

If the fish is cautious and just hitting your bait lightly, it's best to wait, let the fish take the bait, and then set the hook after you feel its weight. But some fish, such as walleye, are known for being light biters, so be ready to respond quickly. Again – know the species you're targeting.

Reel in slack and keep your line taut to increase sensitivity so you can feel the strike and be in a better position to set the hook powerfully.

Set the hook by giving your rod (and consequently the fishing line) a quick jerk backward and up. If you have a fish on line, it will fight back and your line will follow the movements of the fish.

If you're targeting a soft-mouthed fish, setting the hook too hard or re-

peatedly can pull the hook through its mouth.

The motion of setting the hook is relatively simple. But it can sometimes be difficult to tell if you have a bite or if you're just feeling the current or a fish bumping into the bait.


