FLW Winner In 1st Event

CLEWISTON, Fla. In the world of professional bass fishing, few pros fish on pure instinct as well as David Dudley. The Lynchburg, Va., pro has always had a sixth sense for being at the right place at the right time when bass are biting, especially when big money is on the line.

His uncanny talent has led him to one of the most impressive career wins in tournament bass fishing: three FLW Outdoors wins, including the Wal-Mart FLW Tour Championship in 2004 and the Ranger M1 in 2002, and two BASS wins, not to mention being the FLW Outdoors leading money winner with \$1,809,317.

On Saturday, Dudley added another winner's trophy to his mantle and another \$125,000 to his bank account by winning the Wal-Mart FLW Series BP Eastern Division event on Lake Okeechobee.

The Castrol pro took the victory by weighing a limit for 18 pounds, 8 ounces today, giving him a fourday total of 64 pounds, 2 ounces.

Those who know Dudley well know his fishing style is like that of a bass-seeking missile: He flies down the lake until something in his gut says, "Fish there!"

And yet, after the big checks have been handed to Dudley and the accolades trail off, he understandably seems at a loss to describe his undeniable talent in a tangible way.

"It's hard to explain," Dudley remarked after his fourth FLW Outdoors win. "To me fishing is not about a secret lure or a secret spot; it's all about instincts. Knowing when to stay and when to go, not



getting bogged down in the memories of yesterday's catch or last year's tournament."

"But instinct is not something you can simply teach somebody with one lesson. Instincts are honed by time on the water, year after year, with a lot of trial and error. And the biggest things I can say about developing that instinctual feel is that even the bad things that happen on the water are good. Because they teach a lesson. You have to learn to find that silver lining in the bad experiences to make them good experiences.

feeling.

"I actually fished the main lake on the first day," he said. "But when that cold weather came in and the water temperature dropped, I knew the lake was not the place to be. It was time to move to deeper, more stable water."

Dudley found that kind of water in the J&S Canal system. He targeted the intersections of ditches and canals off the main canal with a Fat Free Shad and a Rabbit Dog shaky head with a Zoom Trick Worm, both tied to 10-pound-test Trilene XT.

"On day two, when I caught just 12 pounds and moved up 15 places, that's when I thought I could win," Dudley said. "I only got to fish in the canal for about an hour that day, and I caught the 12

pounds pretty quick. I figured if I could spend the better part of two more days in there and really fish my places, I could probably move way up." Dudley rotated five key canal intersections within a six- or seven-mile range.

"I keyed on the intersections because I felt they were migratory routes back into shallower canals and ditches," he added.

Strader runner-up

Wesley Strader of Spring City, Tenn., excited the crowd packed into the Wal-Mart parking lot with an impressive 20-pound, 1-ounce catch today, but it was still not enough to get anywhere near Dudley's 64-pound mark.

Strader ended up second with a four-day total of 56 pounds, 7 ounces worth \$50,000.

Strader was one of the few anglers to venture up the Kissimmee River, despite its muddy appearance.

"I think the dirty water scared a lot of people off," Strader said. "There was hardly anybody up there. I wish I had gone there the continue to the next page

first day, but I kept fooling around in that lake, and I didn't go up there until day two."

Strader's main weapon was a 5/8ounce Yozuri Rattlin Vibe crankbait tied to 15-pound-test Izorline.

Even though Strader used the same bait the last three days, he had to adjust his water selection each day.

"Some days they were right up shallow on the bank, and other days they were pulled off on the first 2to 4-foot drop," he said. "Every day was different, and I had to fish around a while to find them. In fact, vesterday I caught the 21 pounds where the wind was blowing in on the west bank. Today the wind shifted towards the east bank, and I caught every one of them off the east bank."

Auten third

Todd Auten of Lake Wylie, S.C.,

finished third with a four-day total of 54 pounds, 6 ounces worth \$40,000.

Auten spent a better part of the week pitching a 1/2-ounce Out-

That bite fizzled out on him today, so he moved to Uncle Joe's Cut and began cranking a Brian Bee's Skinny B II down the canal's 2- to 4-foot rock break.

"I was paralleling and keying on rock along the ledge" Auten said. "I'm glad I made the move because I culled out three little ones that I caught in Taylor Creek. But I wish I had done it a little earlier. They were really biting well in there when I had to leave for weigh-in." Martin fourth

Scott Martin of Clewiston, Fla., was the biggest mover of the week, coming all the way from 112th place after day two to finish fourth with a four-day total of 45 pounds, 9 ounces.

Martin spent the last two days in the J&S Canal system fishing a Yozuri Rattlin' Vibe and a Frenzy crankbait tied to Berkley 12-pound Vanish along bluff walls in the canal.

sloping sand banks, but certain stretches have a rock bluff wall that drops straight down into 7 or 8 feet of water," Martin explained. "I was keeping my boat right up against the bluff walls and making long, parallel casts down the wall. Then I would stick my rod tip down in the water against the wall and rip that lipless bait down the wall.

"It was a reaction bite all the way," he added. "The lure had to contact the rock wall to get a bite. If my cast landed too far away from the wall, it was worthless and I'd have to reel it in and make another cast."



Fish Attractants "Are They Worth It"

There has been a lot of controversy over "Fish Attractants" or otherwise known as "Fish Scents" or "Fish Formulas". In the past, I've noticed that many of my former bass angling students as well as my bass guide clients have always come prepared with plenty of "Fish Attractant", and wow! Do they ever use it! They will grab that particular bait that they are using, hold it over the edge of the boat, and really pour it on. Is that method really practical?

I'll explain in a moment, but first let me explain a few things about

"Fish Attractants. There are several different types of "Fish Attractants" on the market today in the multibillion dollar bass fishing industry, and the marketing is very costly! Somewhere the companies have to sell, sell, and sell to make up for the high cost of marketing. Many commercials, whether it be TV, Radio, Magazines, Outdoor Shows, etc., have to get the anglers (like you and me) to buy this stuff! First of all let me explain the importance of "Fish Attractant". A freshwater black bass (Largemouth, Smallmouth, or Spotted) will usually spit out a bait within 2 or 3 seconds if the bass doesn't accept the taste (if it even picks up the bait at all!). On the other side of the coin, if a bass likes the scent or attractant, it can hold the bait up to 30 seconds or more before it spits the bait out.

Fish attractant does not really "Attract" fish, but your odds on setting the hook will be greater by using it rather than not. Now, let's get back to Marketing once again. The companies that manufacture "Fish Attractants" or Scents want the anglers to "Use it by dousing

the bait with it." Well, if you have lots of money, go right ahead! Most tackle shops that I've been to have a variety of Attractants and Scents, and they cost the angler anywhere from \$1.99 up to \$10.00.

When an angler "Douses the bait" several times, He or She is ready for another bottle soon, and that can get expensive after awhile. Now, most plastic baits on the marker today continue to the next page

manufactured with a scent already put in the bait. So why would you want to douse this same bait with additional "Fish Attractant"? It really makes no sense at all does it? However, there is a reason why one would want to buy and use "Fish Attractant". Just think of this; a freshwater black bass can sense 1-200th of a drop of a substance in about 100 gallons of water. Wow, what an accurate sense of taste! This just goes to say that whenever you go fishing in the morning, "Gas-Up" the night before!

Now, let's get right to the point, and hopefully this point can and will save you some of your hardearned cash. When you go fishing, the first thing that you should do before you hit the water is to wash your hands with soap and water, this will "hopefully" clean any foreign scents off of your hands that may get on your baits when you handle them. Second, take that bottle "Fish Attractant" and pour a little bit on your hands and rub them together, like you would a hand lotion. Now you're ready for action because any bait you touch will have this "Fish Attractant" scent added to it. Just think of the money

you will save from just "Pouring or Dousing" the formula over the bait. A bottle of "Fish Attractant" should now last you about 20 times as long as it did before. I will not tell you which ones to buy, but the one I mostly use is formulated by Mr.Goop "Fish Formula", they offer a Garlic and Anise scent the bass seem to like very much. Just keep this in mind when using "Fish Attractants"; the angler! (you and I) are the ones that pay for the high cost of marketing of a product, so of course they want us to use lots of that product! So, "Fish Attractants" are they really worth it? YES! But if you use it like a hand lotion you will find yourselves saving money and getting the same results as



Black Bear Poached

A Nicholas County man has been convicted and received a hefty fine for illegally killing a black bear, according to Captain Mike Pizzino of the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources Law Enforcement Section District 3 Office in Elkins.

Conservation Officer Tim White headed the investigation that led to the arrest and conviction of 46-year old Bernard H. Backus II of Belva , West Virginia . As part of a plea bargain in Nicholas County Magistrate Court in December, Backus was fined \$5,000, the maximum allowable for a first offense violation of the state's bear management laws, and ordered to pay \$500 for replacement of the bear and court costs of \$160.50. He was also ordered to pay \$118 for a scientific

The bones were collected and sent to a forensic lab in British Columbia, Canada, for DNA testing. Three eyewitnesses also gave statements in the case.



Understanding Bass

Bass fishing is a sport like many others that when it comes to knowledge and the understanding of the opponen astands the scrapes, trails, food areas, water areas, runs, and habitats of the deer the more successful the hunter will become at locating them. The same is true with Bass fishing (Bass angling), the more you understand the Bass along with the many different circumstances and conditions you run across the more successful you will be at catching them. So let's talk about a few key factors when it comes to a better understanding of the bass. The first one we will look at would be the survival of the

SURVIVAL: A bass needs three elements to survive which are:

- 1. FOOD
- 2. OXYGEN
- 3. COVER


If any one of these three elements are not present in a body of water a bass could not survive, and just by

knowing why these three elements are so important for a bass's survival it will already start to make you a more successful angler.

The first element we will talk continue to the next page

is FOOD. Contrary to popular belief, shad is NOT! the primary 1st choice of a bass. Although shad is a very common food for the bass as well as other natural baits, the number 1 food choice of a bass is a crawfish (also known as crayfish, crawdads, etc.). A study was performed several years ago where 100 Crawfish and 100 shad were in a tank of water with all species of bass (Smallmouth, Spotted, and Largemouth), and to much surprise the crawfish were eaten 8 to 2 over the shad. There are several reasons for this, but the most important one is that a crawfish is an easy prey for a bass to catch, and they are fairly easy for a bass to find. And once again contrary to popular belief, studies show that there are actually more crawfish found in vegetation areas than around rocky areas (or as some may know as Rip-Rap.)

A bass will eat just about anything at any given time such as: Rats, Mice, Ducklings, Frogs, Snakes, Salamanders, Worms, Lizards, Grubs, Baitfish, Insects, Leeches, etc. (Is it any wonder why all the many different tackle manufacturing companies have so many different shapes and types of artificial baits on the market today?) but, there are certain types of artificial



baits that bass will usually prefer over the others, and a lot of these I cover at my 3-day Bass Fishing School.

The next element of the three is OXYGEN. Oxygen is a element that any living creature needs to survive. The main reason an angler should pay attention to oxygen is that a bass requires it to survive. By knowing water oxygen content in various areas an angler will develop a better understanding why a bass acts the way it does under the many different conditions. When a

Chronic Wasting Disease Discovered

Preliminary test results have detected the Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD) agent in one hunter-harvested deer collected in Hampshire County during the 2006 deer hunting season. "As part of our agency's ongoing and intensive CWD surveillance effort, samples were collected from 1,355 hunter-harvested deer brought to game check-

ing stations in Hampshire County," according to Frank Jezioro, Director for the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources (DNR). "This most recent positive CWD sample was taken from a 21/2-year-old buck harvested during the firearms deer season, and the deer was located within close proximity to the 9 positive cases previously detected in Hampshire County."

CWD has now been detected in a total of 10 deer in Hampshire County (i.e., one road-killed deer, four deer collected by the DNR in 2005, four deer collected by the DNR in 2006 and one hunter-harvested deer during the 2006 deer season). "Our analysis of this CWD surveillance data indicates the disease appears to be found in a relatively small geographical area located near Slanesville, West Virginia," noted DNR continue to the next page

Based upon these CWD surveillance findings, we are taking the steps necessary to implement appropriate management actions designed to control the spread of this disease, prevent further introduction of the disease, and possibly eliminate the disease from the state," Jezioro said.

The following disease management options have been evaluated and implemented by the DNR within the affected area of Hampshire County:

- Continue CWD surveillance efforts designed to determine the prevalence and distribution of the disease;
- Lower deer population levels to reduce the risk of spreading the disease from deer to deer by implementing appropriate antlerless deer hunting regulations designed to increase hunter opportunity to harvest female deer;
- Establish reasonable, responsible and appropriate deer carcass transport restrictions designed to lower the risk of moving the disease to other locations;
- Establish reasonable, responsible and appropriate regulations relating to the feeding and baiting of deer within the affected area to reduce the risk of spreading the disease from deer to deer.

"Landowner and hunter cooperation throughout this entire CWD surveillance effort in Hampshire County has been just terrific," Jezioro noted. "As we strive to meet this wildlife disease challenge and implement appropriate management strategies, the support and involvement of landowners and hunters will continue to be essential. The DNR remains committed

to keeping the public informed and involved in these wildlife disease management actions."

CWD is a neurological disease found in deer and elk, and it belongs to a family of diseases known as transmissible spongiform encephalopathies. The disease is thought to be caused by abnormal, proteinaceous particles called prions that slowly attack the brain of infected deer and elk, causing the animals to progressively become emaciated, display abnormal behavior and invariably results in the death of the infected animal. There is no known treatment for CWD, and it is fatal for the infected deer or elk. It is important to note that currently there is no evidence to suggest CWD poses a risk for humans or domestic animals.

"Our well-trained and professional wildlife biologists, wildlife managers and conservation officers are working diligently to fully implement the DNR 's CWD - Incident Response Plan, which is designed to effectively address this wildlife disease threat," said Jezioro. "Hunters, landowners and other members of the public should feel confident that we have some of the best wildlife biologists and veterinarians in the world, including those stationed at the Southeastern Cooperative Wildlife Disease Study in Athens, Georgia, working collaboratively on this situation."



Season Closing Dates On Game

The West Virginia Division of Natural Resources reminds trappers that the trapping season for fisher will end on January 31, 2007. This will be followed a month later on February 28, 2007, by the closing of hunting and trapping seasons for fox, raccoon, and bobcat. Hunters and trappers are required to tag all bobcat and fisher pelts at an official game checking station within 30 days of the close of their respective seasons. Fox and raccoon pelts are not required to be checked at a game checking station.

Trappers, hunters, and fur dealers are reminded that furs shipped out of West Virginia must have a fur shipping tag that is available at Division of Natural Resources district offices.

Bobcat hunters and trappers also should obtain a CITES seal for each pelt they plan to sell outside of the state of West Virginia. All bobcat pelts, usually exported from the United States by licensed fur buyers, must have a CITES seal from the state where the animal was trapped. These seals may be obtained from the Elkins Operations Center and any Division of Natural Resources district office.





If you are a fisherman who lives inland, chances are you need professional help when it comes to ocean fishing. Freshwater fishing as compared to ocean fishing is as different as day and night. Freshwater fishermen know their streams, rivers and lakes, and know what to expect when fishing same. The average occasional, ocean angler doesn't have a clue, so time to seek professional help. 

Sandpiper Wildwood Rockwood four or five guys from New Jersey. We overheard them saying that a couple of them had been on this mackerel outing with Capt. Stowe before. One guy said, "Several years ago I was on this trip and some woman landed a 57 pound wahoo. It took her well over an hour to get it in. She was so tired I don't think she fished anymore for a long time."

I couldn't believe what I was hearing. I butted in, "Was she redheaded - - about so-so tall (using my hand gesturing about five-foot height)? He answered, "Yes."

I said, "T-that was my wife. Wait til I tell her she's an Urban Legend aboard Miss Hatteras." I was impressed and so were his buddies. Shortly afterwards the boat slowed down and Capt. Stowe let out his drag nets. He said thru his bull horn, "We're gonna get our baitfish here. We'll need 120." He had already assigned a "bait counter" and some volunteers to arm pull the nets back in.

We were after menhaden and small blues for bait. By catching our own bait, it significantly lowered the price of the trip. This was an all day outing for only \$130 perperson.

It took us much longer to get the bait than I remembered. We moved to three or four areas until we got the requisite amount.

Since this was a small group, the captain only brought one mate. Her name was Natalie and she was small in stature.

She could tell several of the anglers (all male on this trip) were getting antsy, so she went around and told the group, "I've always considered it a good sign when it takes us longer to get the bait. Last week we got 'em quick, but only caught three mackerel for the

whole day."

Karl gave me one of those, "What did you get me into" looks. Fortunately, I had not built this trip up for high expectations - - just told him he would enjoy. Some of the smaller charter boats in this area charge several hundred dollars or more for the same duration of time.

Finally though, about 9:30 am, we had our 120 tucked away in the two large aerated live wells located at the stern. The captain announced we had about a forty-five minute ride towards the gulf stream before we started fishing. We're gonna catch fish today!" Fishing with Capt. Spurgeon Stowe is an experience in itself. He doesn't mince words, even over the bullhorn, but can be hilarious and informing at times. Illegal Deer & Bear Kills Lead To Arrests

After seeing a photo in the Lincoln Journal newspaper, Capt. Harvey Scites of the Lincoln County Sheriffs Department called Division of Natural Resources conservation officers to report the individual in the photo as a convicted felon. An investigation by DNR Sergeant Terry Ballard and Corporal Larry Rockel led to the arrests of three Branchland men on various game law violations and the recovery of a massive 16 point antler rack. The huge buck was killed on November 20, 2006, which was opening day of the two week deer firearms season. The record book rack has not dried the required 60 days for official scoring, but preliminary scoring shows it to be in the 190's class.

After killing the monster buck, Alfred Curtis Watts, age 40 of Branchland, West Virginia, had posed for the photo for the newspaper. Alfred Watts could also face federal and state charges of being a convicted felon in possession of a firearm.

Illegal Bear Kill Results in Fines of \$1,400

Division of Natural Resources Conservation Officers Ed Goodson and Larry Harvey received an anonymous complaint of an illegally killed bear in a freezer in Julian, WV (Boone County). Investigation by the officers revealed that Roger Dale Bowman II, age 20, of Peytona, WV, killed the bear out of season while on his job at River Fork Mining in Raleigh County. The bear was then transported to Camp Creek Road, Julian, WV, where it was stored in a home freezer. Bowman was charged with eight game law violations. As of this date he has pled guilty to four of the charges in Raleigh County Magistrate Court and paid \$1,400 in fines, \$321 in court costs, and a \$500 replacement fee. In addition, Bowman's license privileges will be suspended for two years.
