Stonewall Jackson Bassin'

Post spawn bass fishing can be very difficult. After breeding near the shoreline, the bass usually suspend in deeper water. We headed to Stonewall Jackson Lake, in Lewis County, to go after these fish. It was late in June and the fishing style would be different.

Stonewall Jackson Lake was dedicated in 1988. It offers 2,650 acres of fishing water at normal pool. In addition, 15,681 acres are available for public hunting. The lake was named after the famed Confederate general, "Stonewall Jackson", a native of Lewis County. Hunters and fishermen have been enjoying this area since its inception.

I called up my fishing friend, Rick Greathouse, for a chance to tackle these hard to catch bass. There are several ramps along the lake and we chose to put his boat in at the Vandalia Ramp. Having fished this By Mark A. Goudy

lake numerous times with my bass club, I knew that Junebug colored worms would be effective. Rick selected his favorite brand, Zoom. while I decided to experiment with other colors and varieties.

We started fishing around 9am near the ramp area. It wasn't long before Rick got his first bite and landed a keeper sized bass. A keeper sized bass refers to the 12" or longer length that is required in bass fishing tournaments. This lake is actually the first catch-and-release bass fishing lake in the state. All bass must be released.

I was trying many different colors of tubes, worms and creature baits. After Rick had landed some other continue to the next page


bass, I gave up and went to my "old faithful," a junebug Berkley Power Worm. As they say, "fish bite and won't let go." We discovered that the fish were really not related to the shoreline like usual. We had to drag our worm down to around 6 to 10 feet of water before they would contact the lure.

We also fished in the Wolf Run fork of the lake. This area features numerous old trees still submerged in the water. The opening of the channel is over 50' deep. We quit fishing around 5pm and had landed 5 keeper sized bass and numerous smaller "dinks". We had never tried crank baits or spinner baits. These may have worked too.

We left the lake and headed back

We now had a pattern, basically the style and baits needed to catch bass. We went to the Big Skin section of the lake. I finally switched to a buzz bait around dark and hooked a nice suspended largemouth. We ended up with 8 keepers for the day with the biggest landed by Rick, a 17" bass. We probably reeled in around 25 or 30 fish, total. The fishing was tough but rewarding. We had contacted Andy Godwin, sales manager for Mid-State Mari-



na in Sutton. Their company offers Ranger and G3 bass boats, along with several brands of ATV's. Andy is well known in this area for his success in bass fishing tournaments at the nearby lakes. He has also fished in numerous national bass fishing events. I hopped in his

Ranger Comanche bass boat early the following morning for instructions on catching bass in the tall timber scattered throughout the lake. Rick followed us in his boat.

We started back to the left of the Vandalia Ramp through the bridge. The tall trees are in water depths ranging from 15 to 40 feet. He was flipping tubes and Jewel Bait company jigs directly at the trees. He uses a 7'6" Kistler flipping rod. This rod offers tremendous hook setting power.

It wasn't long before I found out one of the reasons for his fishing success. I was looking the other way and heard a loud whooshing noise. It was Andy rearing back for his hook set. I watched him several times through the day setting the hook. He raises his arms high and generates a tremendous amount of power with his motion. Plus his large #4 Owner wide gap hooks offer a very sharp hook.

Over the course of the day, Andy caught several nice bass in the deep water around the trees. His biggest continue to the next page

went over three pounds. We also saw a musky, that looked to be in the 50 inch class, swimming on the surface. Rick caught several keeper bass, too, following behind us. The conditions were not great for fishing. There were very few clouds and the bright sunlight had driven the fish down. Andy only fishes down around 8 feet or so from the surface. He gets his bite below where the sunlight turns to shade in the water. He explained that the suspended bass also use the trees as a source of shade and as an ambush point for attacking nearby bluegills and crappie. Try this method out sometimes in the area that you fish. Fishermen usually go right by productive trees.

Having fished this lake for two days in difficult conditions, we concluded that post spawn fish were available to be caught. I also spoke with Rick Dunlap, owner of Rick's Taxidermy in Buckhannon. He fishes for bass at Stonewall Jackson Lake often. He related one of his recent late June trips with me. He fished the bay across from the Vandalia Ramp using a small Wiggle Wart crankbait. He made one pass around this bay. He was basically looking for suspended fish too. He stated that he landed several keeper sized fish along with one he estimated that would have weighed around 5 1/2 pounds. He also reeled in a walleye around 9 pounds on this same bait.

Since Stonewall Jackson Lake is a catch-and-release bass fishing lake, he offers replica mounts for bass to his many customers. Carry a bendable tape rule with you on this lake. Measure the length and the girth around the fish at its biggest point. He then uses this information to order the replica which he later paints to provide a lasting memory. He

Spend some time on Stonewall Jackson Lake for an opportunity to land huge bass. Many anglers that I have talked with have had super days on the water. Anglers have a realistic chance to land largemouth bass over 5 pounds. Many try late night fishing on the lake using 7" to 10" worms. Bernie Dowler, formerly the Chief Of Wildlife Resources with the DNR, told me years ago that the lake was offering all anglers the chance at landing a 3 to 5 pound bass on any given day. This catch-and-release formula for bass fishing has since been used on other new lakes in the state.



Fatal Accident Update

A suspect has been positively identified in the hunted related fatal shooting of Shawn Craig Stewart, which had occurred on Monday, April 27, 2009, in the Wildlife Management/Public Hunting Area of the Stonewall Jackson Lake State Park.

Robert L. Tobias, age 58, of Millersburg, Pennsylvania, had been identified by law enforcement personnel as being a hunter in this area on the date of this incident. This identification had been made after an article of clothing had been located by searchers near the Charles Run Cove area. During this investigation, this particular article of clothing was determined to have been purchased by TOBIAS from a local sporting goods store. Upon reviewing the exterior video footage from this store, officers learned that TOBIAS had been operating a compact truck with a wooden rack in the bed that was similar to the vehicle that had been described by the hunting companions of the victim as a vehicle they had observed parked at the Vandalia Bay parking lot on Sunday, April 26, 2009 and Monday, April 27, 2009. When contact was made with TOBIAS regarding this article of clothing, he had been unable to produce same and had advised that it had

been lost while recently hunting at the aforementioned State Park. Following this initial contact, TO-BIAS had advised officers that he had retained legal counsel in this matter. Authorities had obtained DNA samples from TOBIAS for comparison to evidence that had been discovered at the scene during the initial part of this investigation. The results of this DNA test are pending, but are expected to be returned to this officer within the following days. During a subsequent interview with TOBIAS and his retained legal counsel, TOBIAS confirmed to officers that he had been the person responsible for this shooting incident. Charges against TOBIAS will be forthcoming.

Corporal D.L. Cayton, lead investigator, advised that this investigation was a text book multi-agency effort to accomplish one goal. The agencies involved in this investigation included the West Virginia State Police, the WVSP Bureau of Criminal Investigations, the WV

DNR, Agents from the Clarksburg and Wheeling offices of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms, the Clarksburg Police Department Detective Division, the Pennsylvania State Police, and the Pennsylvania Game Commission. All of these agencies played a very significant role in this investigation.

Bowfishing 101

Bowfishing is an activity that is rapidly increasing in popularity among fishermen and hunters alike. Taking to the backwater with bow in hand, many people spend as much time and effort bowfishing as other anglers do with rod and reel. It is something which lends itself well to newcomers and seasoned shooters alike and is a great transition sport for fall bowhunters.

Getting started in bowfishing is actually quite simple. It is much more accommodating than beginning bowhunting and a lot less expensive also. Equipment can be purchased easily at second-hand stores, pawn shops, or sporting goods stores for a small investment. Precision fit and quality is not as mandatory as with a hunting or target bow, but still must be matched to the individual shooter.

The various setups for bowfishing can be as unique as the individual shooter and choosing a bow is based strictly on personal preference. It may be either recurve, longbow, or compound. The key to choosing the bow is for the draw weight to be light enough to be drawn very swiftly in a smooth



the fish. Usually, the arrow is made of fiberglass.

If you are a dedicated angler, you may be having angina at this point in the story. Relax. The only fish which can legally be shot with bow and arrow are rough fish. No game fish are allowed to be taken and, for the most part, are non-existent in the locations in which bowfishing normally takes place. Most bowfishing is done in the brackish backwater of sloughs, rivers, and spring floods.

Rough fish such as carp and gar haunt the murky water throughout various sloughs and backwater. These fish move into the shallows in the spring to spawn. Sometimes, these fish can be found in water only inches deep. But don't get the idea that bowfishing is like the proverbial "shooting fish in a barrel." It is far removed from that notion and predominately quite the contrary.

Fish can be quite difficult to hit with bow and arrow and it generally takes a while for one to get the hang of shooting at them. Not only is the target usually moving, but the water has a profound effect on the way the fish appears to the shooter. The refraction of the water makes it necessary to aim below the fish in order to be on target. It can prove to be a bit frustrating at times. water and then hang on. It's a heck of a commotion to say the least.

Bowfishing is very accessible as it can be pursued from boat, the bank, or by wading shallow water. Shooting from the bank usually puts the most limits on the angler. Because bowfishing often takes place in shallow water, wading provides access to countless opportunities. on bowfishing pleasure.

Wading and boat fishing are performed with similar technique. The bow-angler scans the surface of the water looking for activity. When a fish is spotted "working" the angler quietly approaches for the pending shot. Bowfishing dictates that the angler must be quite close to the quarry before a shot is attempted.

Bowfishing is not for everyone. However, some people take it very seriously. Many people build special boats from which to bowfish. Elevated platforms are constructed on the boats from which to give a better vantage point to see fish in the water below.

Contemporary fishing is adorned with all manner of tournaments and prizes. The bowfishing fraternity is not without its tournaments either. The tournaments are very similar to any other fishing tournament. Each person or team pays an entrance fee, must fish following certain guidelines, and must check in the catch at days end. Winners are determined in various categories such as most fish brought in, heaviest fish, and longest fish. Prizes are awarded in the form of trophies and cash.

Getting started in bowfishing is not hard. If one is accustomed to shooting a bow, it is a definite advantage, but not mandatory. It is very important for the shooter to use a bow which fits his or her draw length and strength. High-poundage bows are not necessary and are actually

a detriment to success. One must shoot quickly when a fish appears, so being "over-bowed" is a definite disadvantage in bowfishing.

It does not have to be an expensive rig either. Simple, inexpensive, and sometimes used equipment will serve nicely for starting out. Most any archery shop can give advice on setting up a bow for bowfishing and much more information is available from local

Special September Deer Season

Archery and muzzleloader deer hunters in West Virginia will be able to enjoy additional antlerless deer hunting opportunities this fall, according to Frank Jezioro, Director of the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources. The Natural Resources Commission recently approved a special antlerless deer archery season and a special antlerless deer muzzleloader season that will take place on private lands only in selected counties where the harvest of additional antlerless deer is necessary for management purposes. Hunters should be aware of the following details associated with these special antlerless deer seasons.

The special antlerless deer archery season will open on September 14, 2009, and close on September 19, 2009, and allow for the taking of one additional deer that must be checked on a Class RB or Class RRB Stamp.

The special antlerless deer muzzle-loader season will open on September 21, 2009, and close on September 21, 2009.

tember 26, 2009, and allow for the taking of one additional deer that must be checked on a Class RM or Class RRM Stamp.

Both the special antlerless deer archery season and the special antlerless deer muzzleloader season will take place on private lands only in the following counties or portions thereof: Barbour, Berkeley, Brooke, Cabell, Calhoun, Doddridge, Gilmer, Grant, Greenbrier (S of Rt. 60, S of I-64, S&E of Rt. 9, E of Rt. 219 at Renick, S of Rt. 11, W of Greenbrier R., S of I-64, W of Rt. 60/14), Hampshire, Hancock, Hardy, Harrison, Jackson, Jefferson, Kanawha (N or Elk R. & W of Corridor G), Lewis, Marion, Marshall, Mason, Mercer (E of I-77), Mineral, Monongalia, Monroe, Morgan, Ohio, Pendleton, Pleasants, Preston, Putnam, Ritchie, Taylor, Tyler, Wetzel, Wirt and Wood.

"These special antlerless deer seasons will afford archery and muzzleloader hunters an excellent opportunity to hunt deer earlier in



the year and during a time when weather conditions are generally milder," Jezioro said. "These seasons have the added advantage of allowing hunters and landowners to harvest additional antlerless deer from private lands where needed for management purposes."

Spring Gobbler Hunting Results

Preliminary figures indicate West Virginia hunters harvested 9,485 bearded turkeys statewide during the recently completed 2009 spring gobbler season. This year's spring harvest is approximately four percent below the 9,929 birds taken in 2008.

The top five counties in 2009 were Mason (422), Preston (378), Harrison (310), Upshur (296) and Wood (273). Thirty of the state's 55 counties had lower harvests this spring when compared to 2008. District 6 showed the greatest percentage decline (down 12 percent), followed by District 4 (down nine percent), District 5 (down three percent) and District 1 (down three percent). Higher harvests were reported in District 2 (up three percent) and District 3 (up three percent). District 1 reported the largest kill (2,130 birds), followed by District 4 (1,737), District 6 (1,700), District 5 (1,650), District 3 (1,426) and District 2 (842).

"Just as we saw last year, the 2009 spring turkey season experienced many days of rain," said Curtis I.

Taylor, Chief of the Wildlife Resources Section of the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources. "This wet weather dampened hunter turnout, reduced gobbling activity and resulted in a lower than expected harvest."

Biologists had forecast a spring harvest of more than 10,000 gobblers for 2009, based on improved brood counts the past two years. "Reports from field personnel during this spring season indicated hunting pressure was lower than normal," said Taylor. "Much of this decrease in hunting can be attributed to the very foul weather conditions."

There should be a good amount of carryover birds for 2010.

Stonewall WMA Hunting Permits

Applications are being accepted for the controlled deer hunt scheduled for November 16, 17 and 18, 2009, at Stonewall Resort State Park, located in Lewis County near Weston, W.Va.

"Monitoring of the deer population and subsequent surveys conducted by the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources (DNR) revealed a high deer density on the state park property at Stonewall," according to Sam England, Park Superintendent. "The excessive whitetail deer population damages vegetation, creates environmental imbalance within the park and subjects the herd to increasingly poor browse and health conditions."

Cooperative efforts between the Parks and Recreation, Wildlife, and Law Enforcement sections of DNR and Benchmark Management Company, which operates the facilities for the state, were successful in conducting a controlled hunt in 2008.

"We were able to successfully use a controlled hunt as a method of deer management in a public setting last year; however, history has shown that multiple successive hunts are necessary to reduce the population to appropriate levels," according to

during this hunt, except that each day of the hunt an on-site lottery will be held which will allow up to four (4) hunters to hunt a deer of either sex. Instructions on the application must be followed. Applications must be signed, legible, complete, and postmarked by August 28, 2009.

All applicants must designate the type of weapon (firearm or bow) and hunting method (free roaming or fixed stand) to be used on the application. All persons applying as a party must hunt with the same type of weapon (firearm or bow) and use the same method of hunting (free roaming or fixed stand). Party hunters which include a Class Q hunter must hunt from the same Class Q stand.

Each hunter must possess a valid West Virginia Hunting License (or be legally exempt from purchasing a license) on the day of the hunt.

from elevated tree stands (ladder or self-climbing) which they must provide, placed in designated trees. In the Free Roaming Zone hunters may hunt from the ground or from portable tree stands and they are not limited to stationary location. A safety belt is required to be worn while hunting from an elevated stand. Scopes are allowed on all legal firearms.

There will be no waiting list or walk-ons. There will be approximately 55 applications for each hunt day randomly drawn in advance. Successful applicants will be contacted with more detailed information regarding this controlled hunt. Deer harvested do not count against a hunter's annual deer season bag limit.

West Virginia Division of Natural Resources hunting regulations will apply to this hunt. Hunting contributes to wildlife conservation while maintaining a healthy deer herd population.










More Deer Test Positive For CWD

Test results have detected the Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD) agent in a total of seven white-tailed deer sampled during the 2009 spring collections in Hampshire County, according to the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources (DNR).

These most recent deer testing positive for CWD were collected by Wildlife Resources Section personnel working in cooperation with local landowners, and they were all located within the Hampshire County CWD Containment Area (i.e., that portion of Hampshire County located North of U.S. Route 50). The CWD agent previously has been detected outside the containment area in the adjacent portion of Hampshire County, and the area of known infected deer does continue to slowly expand.

These collections have been designed to investigate and determine the prevalence and distribution of the disease in Hampshire County. In addition, wildlife biologists are

inia was confirmed on September 2,2005. Since then, DNR has been fully engaged in activities guided by its CWD Incident Response Plan, which is designed to accomplish the following objectives.

Determine the distribution and prevalence of CWD through enhanced surveillance efforts.

Communicate and coordinate with the public and other appropriate agencies on issues relating to CWD and the steps being taken to respond to this disease.

Initiate appropriate management actions necessary to control the spread of this disease and prevent further introduction of the disease.

To date, CWD surveillance efforts conducted by the DNR have resulted in a total of 45 deer being confirmed positive for CWD in Hampshire County. Ongoing and extensive surveillance efforts being conducted by Wildlife Resources Section personnel throughout West Virginia have not detected CWD outside of Hampshire County.

CWD is a neurological disease found in deer and elk, and it belongs to a family of diseases known as transmissible spongiform encephalopathies. The disease is thought to be caused by abnormal, proteinaceous particles called prions that slowly attack the brain of infected deer and elk, causing the animals to progressively become emaciated, display abnormal behavior and invariably results in the death of the infected animal. There is no

known treatment for CWD, and it is fatal for the infected deer or elk. It is important to note that currently there is no evidence to suggest CWD poses a risk for humans or domestic animals.

"Landowner and hunter cooperation throughout this entire CWD surveillance effort in Hampshire County continues to be excellent," noted DNR Director Frank Jezioro. "As we strive to meet this wildlife disease challenge and implement appropriate management strategies, the support and involvement of landowners and hunters remains essential. DNR is committed to keeping the public informed and involved in these wildlife disease

"Our well trained and professional wildlife biologists, wildlife managers and conservation officers are working diligently to effectively address this wildlife disease threat, and we are collaborating with nationally recognized wildlife disease experts at the Southeastern Cooperative Wildlife Disease Study in Athens, Georgia," said Jezioro.




