

2023 Gun Season Buck Harvest

SOUTH CHARLESTON, W.Va. — Preliminary data collected from the electronic game checking system indicated that deer hunters in West Virginia harvested 45,155 antlered deer during the two-week firearm season from Nov. 20 through Dec. 3, the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources (WVDNR) announced today.

The 2023 harvest was 7.5 percent below the 2022 harvest, which totaled 48,810 bucks.

"The harvest during the 2023 traditional buck firearm season was expected to be lower than that of 2022," said Paul Johansen, chief of the Wildlife Resources Section. "Average hard mast indices paired with bad weather during the opening few days of the buck firearms season probably hindered the success of many hunters this season. All areas of the state registered an average decrease of 11 percent; with the exception of the southeastern areas that had an increase of 19 percent from the 2022 harvest."

The top 10 counties for the 2023 buck harvest were Greenbrier (1,892), Randolph (1,604), Preston (1,413), Pendleton (1,413), Monroe (1,396), Braxton (1,394),



Smallmouth Tactics

Smallmouth bass are one of the most sought-after fish species in the United States. According, to the Smithsonian Institute, smallmouth bass are present in 43 states in the United States (Smithsonian Environmental Research Center 2023). They are known for their magnificent color patterns and tenacious fight they put up when caught. The current world record smallmouth bass was caught by David Hayes at Dale Hollow Lake and weighed 11lbs 15 oz. The length record in West Virginia is 25.5 inches. It was caught in the New River by Franklin Elliot. The weight record in West Virginia was caught by David Lindsay in the South Branch of the Potomac



In small rivers and creeks, the population of trophy smallmouth can be limited but still provide excellent opportunities for anglers that do not have a boat or a kayak. However, investment in a kayak can increase the places you can fish for "bronze backs." To get your hands on a 20-inch smallmouth bass in West Virginia, you will need to acquire the skills to increase your chances of landing one.

Equipment

To catch smallmouth in small streams or creeks I recommend that you use a 6 foot 6 or 7-foot medium action rod with a fast tip. You could even go smaller Pflueger President. When startusing a 6-foot or 6-foot 4 rod.

ent anglers what lures to use on

smallies you might get 100 different answers. Before we proceed to what lures I recommend when targeting these fish, it is important to know I have zero sponsorship, I use what works. We will go over four different lure choices that I have found to be productive day in and day out. The first lure I start with is a 4-inch stick bait in green pumpkin. My favorite is a YUM Dinger. Why a YUM Dinger and not something like a Yamamoto Senko? Price. YUM

pared to Yamamoto Senko that can be up to around \$8.00. When using this lure, you simply cast it, let it sink to the bottom, raise your rod to hop it off the bottom and let it sink again. The fish will usually bite on the fall. It is important to watch your line for any signs a fish has hit it because anglers will not always feel the strike. Usually, your line will just "take off" in the water, that is when you crank

down and set the hook. I usually Texas rig the YUM Dinger with a 3/0 offset worm hook round bend made by Gamakatsu with a 1/16 oz Eagle Claw Pro Series worm weight.

Secondly, another effective lure to catch a bronze back is the Nikko Hellgrammite. This lure is a little on the pricey side, however, with the elasticity of the plastic I found it to be good for catching 20-30

fish before it tears up. I work the Nikko Hellgrammite like the YUM Dinger. Similarly, you need to be a line watcher for this lure to detect bites. In my experience, the natural color Texas rigged with a 1/0 Gamakatsu worm hook round bend and a 1/16 oz Eagle Claw Pro Series worm weight is my goto. I tend to Texas rig soft baits that are worked slowly to avoid snags.

When throwing moving baits, I gravitate towards a 3-inch Keitech Easy Shiner swimbait. These lures can be effective when the bass are out chasing baitfish. Keitech has a plethora of colors to choose from but in my tackle box I carry the following: Smallmouth Magic, Green Pumpkin Charcontinue to the next page

reuse, Green Pumpkin, Alewife, and French Pearl. These baits are rigged on a 1/8 oz Revenge Darter jig head (discontinued) but can easily be paired with a Keitech jig head that are available on their website. When fishing this lure, I usually use a straight retrieve. It is an effective strategy to let it sink to the bottom before you start the retrieve.

Lastly, a lure that is often overlooked is the tube style bait. My brother and father have been fishing tubes their whole life. We still have numerous packs of Cabin Creek Baits who have recently been bought out by Georgia Lure Company. Although Georgia Lure Company does not offer tube baits on their website at the time of this writing there are several companies such as Strike King, Berkely, Get Bit Baits, etc. that offer these lures. One company I do not have experience with but will try when my family runs out of Cabin Creek tubes, is the Secret Lures Company Stupid Tube. This company offers lures and jig heads that make the tube completely weedless to avoid snags. I usually go for green pumpkin

or smoke-colored tubes paired with the infamous Oldham's jig heads that come from Texas. Fishing a tube is like fishing a stick bait. There have been times I've thrown a variety of lures in my arsenal and then resort back to the

tube bait and get bit. Tube baits mimic crawfish that can be found in most creeks and streams.

deep hole up a creek that is tribu- if that body of water is wadable strategy for catching smallies. Fish will come up these creeks in early spring to spawn enabling anglers to pick off big fish. Also, when scouting out a new stream to wade for smallmouth, I always look for rocky bottoms in that body of water. Rocky bottomed creeks and riverbeds will usually hold smallmouth, not to mention they play a big factor determining

tary to a river can be an effective or not. The best approach is to walk the stream passing through the shallows to get from hole to hole. I have caught many smallmouth bass in two feet of water so it's important to cast to every part of the stream to catch the fish that are spread throughout. Generally speaking, the deeper the hole the more concentrated the fish are. Fore example. If you see a rope swing, which are usually

placed over deep holes, it's more likely than not there is a fish in there. As with most bass fishing, it is important to target structure. Submerged boulders, trees, rock piles, and weed lines are all high percentage areas that should not be overlooked. Wading for me has always been a favorite past time. In the high-tech world of social media, smart phones, and instant information, it's important to reconnect with nature and experience the outdoors. Who knows? You might just hook into that 20inch smallmouth!



What do rabbits eat in the winter time?

In winter, rabbit's diet routine changes. Natural vegetation food supply run out as consumed by other rabbit or wild animals. Plants like clover, tender young plants, berries and vegetables will no more or difficult to find because of snow. In such rough weather, wild rabbits generally

Are rabbits more active at night? Yes, they are more active at night. As mentioned earlier, Rabbits as nocturnal game animal sleeps in day for hours and play at night in their den or in pet home. Wild rabbits come out in sun down and first light just to be safe from predators.

Some prefers hunting in snow in compare to early season because in winter you can track rabbits foot step in the snow. Moreover, in extreme cold weather rabbits are bound to take shelter from the rough weather, that makes them simple to find and less likely to disappear in the wild.

search for rabbit tracks that lead to good hiding places and reveal no sign of leaving. Then hunt the hiding places around thoroughly. Are rabbits less active in winter?

No, Rabbits are not less active in the winter. They are not uncomfortable in cold weather so they don't need to hibernate. They regularly look for food sources all over the winter to remain warm and alive.

These rabbits are not generally visible in winter because they are solely active on dusk and dawn. They come out this time because the weather is gentle and less light outside which eventually decreases their possibilities of being hunted by a predator.

Do wild rabbits have babies in the winter?

Yes, wild rabbits have babies in the winter. In general, rabbits breeding season is in late fall. When the temperature falls they start to breed from early October to December. In the off-season they avoid mating with each other and blissfully coexist without brawling.

But some research showed that around 30 percent of Cottontail rabbits survive winter. It may seem less but cottontail rabbits breed February-September and their breeding rate is so high. A female rabbit can make up to 6 litters per year with 1-8 babies per litter


On Dec. 8, Michael John Drake of St. Albans, WV, caught and released a blue catfish weighing 69.45 pounds and measuring






