





Summer Crappie Fishing

For those resilient anglers who tactics for catching summer's fincan tolerate the sweltering heat, mosquitoes and sunburn that often are part of summer fishing, this season provides excellent opportunities for hooking lots of big crappie.

Unfortunately, many hot-weather crappie outings end in failure. Why?

Mainly because anglers insist on using the same fishing methods they use during the crappie's spring spawning season, and these methods rarely entice slabs when the water is as hot as a jacuzzi. Success comes only to those anglers who know specific

icky fish.

Toward that end, here are 9 seldom-used tips to help you nab hot-water crappie this time of year. Study them, employ them and enjoy the bounty.

Attract Minnows, Attract Crappie When fishing is slow during daylight hours, try an approach that duplicates the use of a crappie light at night. A light attracts insects, which in turn attracts minnows. But minnows also are attracted by chumming with dry dog food, bread crumbs or similar offerings. Scatter the chum by handfuls in several shallow-water areas, then move back to the first place you put chum and drop in a minnow. Fish each consecutive

Scale Drop

Here's another "chumming" method to try when fishing is slow. Save some scales from the next crappie you dress. Rinse

them and store inside a sealable container filled with water. Carry the container on your outings, and if things get slow, drop a few scales in the water above inundated cover. As the scales fall, they flicker and catch the eye of crappie, which often will move toward them to investigate. A jig or minnow presented on a tight line in the vicinity may get hit.

Stump Knocking

A double-hook, bottom-bouncing rig provides an excellent means for waylaying summer crappie holding near stumps on flats adjacent bottom channels. A 1-ounce bell sinker tied at line's end allows the angler to feel the bottom and find the stumps. Above the sinker are tied two 6-inch drop loops 18 continue to page 7

inches apart, and a crappie hook is tied to each dropper. The rig is baited with live minnows or jig/minnow combos.

While wind drifting or slow trolling with an electric motor, work the rig in a lift-drop fashion. When you feel the rig bump against a stump, lift it up and over. Strikes often come just as the rig is lowered behind woody cover. Go With the Flow

If you know some areas where waterfalls tumble into the main body of a lake or stream during summer, head straight for them on your next hot-weather outings. These may be naturally occurring waterfalls or man-made structures of concrete, steel or rocks that create drop-offs with running water. These spots oxygenate water that might otherwise get stale

and lifeless when temperatures are bumping 100. Reeling a small deep-diving minnow-imitation crankbait through the bubbling water is an excellent way to encontinue to the next page

boats may fail to get bites because crappie can see the fishermen. These same fish may bite, however, when the angler walks on the structure and fishes from above.

Crappie get used to foot traffic on these structures and seldom spook, so the quiet overhead approach often works when a bait presented from a boat won't. Let the wind drift a minnow or jig suspended under a bobber into the shade beneath the structure. Or try fishing vertically through wide cracks in boards that lie over the shadiest water.

Side-trolling

When trolling for deep summer crappie, try mounting your trolling motor on the side of the boat instead of the front. This allows you to move in a very slow, controlled fashion so you can mine deep structures more efficiently.

Glow-in-the-Dark Tactics

Many jigs now are available with glow-in-the-dark bodies and/or heads. Do they work? Sometimes yes, sometimes no, in my experience. But at times, when conventional jigs aren't producing, I've rigged with a luminescent version and started catching crappie after crappie. Rigging a small cyalume (light) stick a foot or so ahead of the jig often improves effectiveness.

Crickets and Mayflies

Summer mayfly hatches are common on many crappie lakes,

and when they occur, crappie move shallow to gorge on mayfly larvae and emerging adults. If you see numerous mayflies, dispense with lures and minnows, and try fishing an unweighted cricket instead. Although a cricket hardly resembles a mayfly, hungry crappie filling their bellies on insects won't refuse one. Hook the cricket through the collar to keep it lively, then flip it on top of the water and wait for the hit.





WV DNR Boater Education Course

West Virginia is home to wideopen lakes, expansive rivers and tranquil streams. With more than 2,000 miles of navigable, fishable streams, its easy to see why Almost Heaven is a popular boating destination. Throughout the state you'll 21 large lakes, 41 small impoundments as well as 30 ponds that are managed by the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources. These beautiful, flowing waters are available for boating, outdoor recreation and memory making adventures.

Before heading out, it's important to know the rules of the waters in West Virginia. Anyone born on or after Dec. 31, 1986 must successfully complete a Boating Safety Education Course before operating a motorboat or personal watercraft upon the waters of this state (20-7-12b).

The certificate must have been obtained by satisfactorily completing a course of instruction in boating safety education administered by the United States Coast Guard Auxiliary; the United States Power Squadron; the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources; any person certified to teach the course administered by



Largest Spring Turkey Harvest In 5 Years

FARMINGTON, W.VA. — Ac- bler season. cording to preliminary data released by the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources on Wednesday, hunters in the Mountain State harvested 12.217 bearded turkeys during the spring gob-

The harvest is 30.4 percent above last year's harvest of 9,366 birds, 12.6 percent above the fiveyear average of 10,850 birds and 14.6 percent above the ten-year average of 10,661. It is also the

largest harvest since 2018, when 12.287 birds were taken.

"The increased harvest is a testament to the dedicated efforts of our hunters and the successful management of our turkey populations and we're thrilled to see such encouraging harvest numbers for the spring gobbler season in West Virginia," said WVDNR Director Brett McMillion. "It's especially exciting to note that this year's harvest surpasses both the five-year and ten-year averages, indicating a positive trend in the turkey population. The WVD-

DNR remains committed to maintaining sustainable wildlife management practices to ensure the long-term health and abundance of turkeys in our state."

Harvest increases were reported in every WVDNR District except District 4, which had a slight decrease. Hunters in District 1 harvested the most birds (2.563). followed by District 6 (2,206), District 5 (2,148), District 4 (1,871), District 2 (1,766) and District 3 (1,663). The top five counties with the highest turkey harvests were Mason (559), Jackson (416), Preston (390), Harrison (357) and Hampshire (347) counties.

"I want to congratulate all of our successful hunters who helped make this year's spring gobbler harvest the best it's been in five years," said West Virginia Department of Commerce Secretary James Bailey. "Our state's hunting seasons play a vital role in bolstering our economy and supporting local businesses and communities. Together, we will continue to foster a thriving outdoor



As part of the survey, participants will be asked to report river otter sightings and provide details about the otter's location, the number of otters observed and what the otter was doing. Submitting a photo of the otter is encouraged.

The survey, which is similar to

the box turtle and rattlesnake citizen science surveys the WVDNR have conducted, will provide updated information about the bodies of water river otters currently occupy. Data collected during the survey will help the WVDNR better manage river otter populations across West Virginia.

River otters, which were once

extirpated in West Virginia, were reintroduced to the state by the WVDNR in the 1980s. Since then, river otter populations have stabilized and are increasing in certain areas.

Tiger Trout Information

One of the most vividly-decorated and least-encountered trout in the water is the tiger trout. As its scientific name, Salmo trutta × Salvelinus fontinalis suggests, the tiger trout is a sterile hybrid between the brook trout (Salvelinus fontinalis) and the brown trout (Salmo trutta). They're known for having very distinct vermiculation, the same pattern that's more subtly seen on the backs of brook trout.

Tiger trout are found across much of the country, as they are almost entirely a stocked fish. While they can occasionally occur naturally in areas with brook and brown trout, they aren't nearly as easy to produce as other hybrids, like cutbows. Brook trout have two more pairs of chromosomes than brown trout, making it much harder for these two species to produce viable offspring in the wild.

However, using a method called heat shocking, scientists can

quite easily create tiger trout for stocking. They're stocked for a variety of reasons, from being a sport fishery to controlling other fish populations (tigers are both sterile and piscivorous, so they can control the populations of other species without becoming a problem themselves). They're found in many of the same types of habitat as other species and are

Tiger trout are aggressive, and although they have similar diets to other trout species when they're small, most switch to a diet of baitfish once they grow larger. Because of this, they can get fairly large. Tigers of two to five pounds are commonly caught, and the record is over 20 pounds.

So how do tiger trout stack up against their parent species, the brook and brown trout? In my opinion, they take more of their looks from brook trout but definitely have a personality closer to that of a brown.

The deep, vivid vermiculation across their sides and back is reminiscent of the brook trout's patterns. They also sometimes have a duller version of the red belly and fins of a brookie. However, they're easy to tell apart from a continue to the next page

brook trout, as the red generally isn't as vivid, and they lack the iconic blue halo spots.

The color scheme of tigers is similar to a brown in that they often have a tan background coloration, but their size, aggression, and diet are what really give away their relation to the brown trout.

Luckily for the tiger trout angler, the hardest part of catching tiger trout is actually finding them, since they mostly exist only where they've been stocked. Once you're into them, though, getting them to take a fly isn't any more complicated than fishing for any other species of trout, and many would argue that they're easier to catch than other species due to their aggressive nature.

When tiger trout are small, their diet is similar to other trout species, and insects will be on the menu. Most standard nymphs or dry flies work great. Beadhead nymphs, generic dries, and any continue to page 23

Freshwater Fish Species

One of the most important steps you can take to become a more successful freshwater angler is to learn about the types of freshwater fish species you want to catch. Whether your goal is to catch a largemouth bass or take your kids fishing, these freshwater tips and tricks will help you.

The more knowledge you have about the different types of freshwater fish habitats and feeding habits, the better an angler you can become, and you will be better equipped to follow the state fishing laws and regulations for each species.

WARMWATER, COLDWATER, AND COOLWATER SPECIES

Freshwater fish species are generally separated into one of three different categories (warmwater, coldwater or coolwater) based on water temperature and the associated amount of oxygen in the waexample, cold water holds more oxygen than warm water, which means coldwater fish will require higher oxygen levels in order to survive.

Warmwater fish species: These fish can live in a wide range of Largemouth conditions. bluegill, catfish, crappies and sunfish are all considered warmwater species. Although they can survive cold winters in the northern states and can be found throughout most of the U.S., warmwater species will thrive best when water temperatures are around 80 degrees Fahrenheit.

Coldwater fish species: The second category of freshwater fish is the coldwater species category. As you might imagine, coldwater fish species require cold water temperatures in order to survive. Trout, Salmon, and Smelt are July/August 2023 ~ Page 22

ter at each temperature range. For some of the most common coldwater game fish species. These types of freshwater fish prefer water temperatures between 50 and 60 degrees. Because these species grow best in colder tempatures they are most often found in the northern states or states with higher elevation and cold wind temperatures.

> Coolwater fish species: The third category of freshwater fish is the coolwater species category. Muskellunge, northern pike, walleye, and yellow perch are among the most common coolwater game fish species. These types of freshwater fish prefer water temperatures in-between the other two categories. Because these species grow best in water temperatures that range in the 60's and 70's,

Once they start to put on some size, they can still be caught on typical dries and nymphs, but many start to target larger prey items like baitfish. At this point, it's time to switch to streamers to match that change.

Once again, fishing streamers for tiger trout isn't rocket science. Don't fall into the trap of choosing flies that catch anglers instead of fish. Woolly buggers, sculpins, and other large, fishy flies with some action should be enough to trigger a tiger to feed.

Encountering a tiger trout by chance happens, but it's rare. If your strategy for catching one is to just keep fishing where there are brooks and browns and hoping for the best, you're fighting a losing battle.

Luckily, because they're easy to create and stock, it's often not hard to look to your state's fish and game agency to find out where they live. And often, because they're stocked in large batches, if you go to a place that has tiger trout, you're likely to find many. Many lakes and ponds contain primarily tiger trout.

Large Trout Stocking This Year

CHARLESTON, W.VA. - The ceptional fishing experience for West Virginia Division of Natural Resources announced on Wednesday that the agency has stocked nearly 130,000 more trout in 2023 compared to the previous year.

Between January and May 2023, the WVDNR stocked 802,481 trout in lakes and streams around the state, which is a 19 percent increase over the 673,148 trout that were stocked during the same period in 2022.

"Our hatchery program plays a crucial role in creating an ex-

anglers across West Virginia," said WVDNR Director Brett Mc-Million."This significant increase in trout going into our lakes and streams can be attributed to investments in our hatchery infrastructure and the dedicated work of our staff."

One of the most significant investments was the expansion of the Bowden Hatchery from 40 fish rearing units to 60, which will allow the WVDNR to produce an additional 100,000 pounds of trout. Other improvements have been made to the Edray, Reed's Creek and Tate Lohr hatcheries





Summer Bass Fishing Pro Tips

Summer can be a challenging er, but I actually don't start until time of year in the South, but you can definitely catch fish, if you get the timing right. Between guiding and my sponsor/media work, I spend a lot of time on the water, but it's actually the opposite of what you might think I do.

I know a lot of people like to fish early and late because it's cool-

about 11 o'clock this time of year. Where I live in east Texas, they bite really good in the middle of the afternoon when it's hot and the sun's the highest.

I prefer this period because I'm catching the deeper schools offshore, and they set up the best when the sun's hottest and when the thermocline gets down the farthest. It just sets them up right when it's hot and sunny like that.

I catch these fish on a variety of baits — big worms, big jigs, big crankbaits, big spoons. Every

By Lee Livesay spot's a little different, but they're best during that midday heat.

You can catch shallow fish better during the early morning and late afternoon hours, but this time of year, I'm fishing the midday period just to catch fish deep offshore. It's really a matter of personal preference.

If you prefer that shallow game, start early, take a break, and then go back out in the late afternoon. You can catch them a lot of different ways, but a big topwater like continue to the next page

the 6th Sense Catwalk can produce some pretty exciting strikes. Just recently, a buddy of mine caught an 11-pounder on a topwater on O.H. Ivey.

Another one that's hard to beat this time of year is a big worm. I always have a Texas-rigged 11-inch, plum colored Netbait C-Mac tied on, whether I'm fishing early in the morning, late in the afternoon or in the middle of the day.

I really like to hop my big worm down here, kind of like stroking a big football jig. I like to drag it 4 to 5 feet, then I'll hop it way

up off the bottom to get those fish to react and get a fish in a school to see it and come over there and check it out.

If I had to choose a personal favorite summertime bait, it would be a 6th Sense Hybrid Jig with a Netbait Paca Craw. I always keep that jig tied on this time of year — I used that same setup when I won the 2022 Elite on Lake Fork.

I'll fish that jig in a variety of places, but a lot of them are little hard spots, like a road bed or a point with timber on it. You can throw that jig on any type of continue to the next page

any type of structure and catch fish.

Whatever you choose to fish during the summertime, I always advise people to take the heat seriously. I wear Huk clothing and with the Waypoint Hoodie and fishing pants, the sun gloves, facemask and a big hat. I keep my body completely covered.

Along with the proper clothing and polarized glasses, you'll want to drink plenty of water, use your sunscreen and pay attention to the weather. When a storm comes through, the fish might go to biting, but if there's a lot of lightning, the bite can turn off.

When that happens, I'm already off the water anyway.




