#### **New State Record Fish**

Gov. Jim Justice announced today that the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources (WVDNR) has reported two new state record fish catches at New Creek Lake in February - a redbreast sunfish and a tiger trout. The catches follow a record blue catfish caught in December 2023 on the Ohio River.

"These record-breaking catches show that West Virginia is truly a world-class fishing destination with opportunities as diverse as our fish populations," Gov. Justice said. "It also proves that we go above and beyond when it comes

WVDNR added the species to the a soft-plastic minnow and a state record list on Jan. 1, 2024. The agency also added redear, pumpkinseed, black crappie and redhorse to the list. Each species has a minimum length set by WVDNR fishery biologists that anglers must meet or surpass to qualify for a state record for the species.

Record Tiger Trout - On the cover Nathaniel Smith of Burlington, W.Va., caught a 26.73-inch, 11.98-pound tiger trout with

4-pound test line from the shoreline of New Creek Lake (Dam 14) on Feb. 24. Smith's record tiger trout broke the weight record previously held by Mike Connolly, whose fish weighed 10.65 pounds and was 28.7 inches long. #### **New State Record Bowfin Caught**

SOUTH CHARLESTON, W.Va. Million. - The West Virginia Division of Natural Resources (WVDNR) announced today that an angler has caught a state record bowfin on the Ohio River in Mason County, making this the fourth state record catch confirmed since December 2023.

"There's nothing quite as exciting as finding a trophy at the end ing catch comes less than a week of your line and we're thrilled that West Virginia anglers keep reeling in record catches and showing the world that our state is truly a world-class fishing destination,"

The record fish, a 10.60-pound, 30.20-inch bowfin, was caught and released on March 12 by Lauren Noble from Letart in Mason County using a small crankbait. Noble's record bowfin was certified by WVDNR District 5 fish biologist Jeff Hansbarger.

#### Hamner Wins The **Bassmaster Classic**

TULSA, Okla. - When most anglers win the Super Bowl of Bass Fishing, they at least pretend like it came as the biggest surprise of their lives.

But not Justin Hamner.

The fourth-year Bassmaster Elite Series pro from Northport, Ala., said openly that he "just had a feeling" coming into this year's Bass Pro Shops Bassmaster Classic presented by Jockey Outdoors that he was going to win — and in three days on Grand Lake O' the Cherokees, he turned that feeling into a hard-core reality.

Hamner completed an assault on B.A.S.S. history with a Championship Sunday limit of five bass that weighed 15 pounds, 13 ounces, and pushed his three-day total to 58-3. He became only the 10th angler in the 54-year history of the event to lead all three days.

"I have no idea what's been going on, but this past month has been pretty dang good," said Hamner, who earned \$300,000 and the coveted Ray Scott trophy. "I can't explain it, but I really did feel like I had a good chance to win."

On day I used a shad-colored, deep-diving jerkbait to put to-



gether a limit that weighed 22-6 and gave him the Day 1 lead.

He went back there for Day 2. But, just like in practice, he couldn't replicate a pattern and was forced to redirect.

"The wind was blowing a ton of bait into the pocket I was fishing," he said. "When all of that bait got in there, those fish were keyed in

"The first two didn't bother me at all," he said. "I still had that calm feeling. But around 1 o'clock, the fish changed and wouldn't even react. I don't know what caused what."

This state-of-the-art facility is expected to draw in thousands of new visitors who will witness the majesty of the elk herd while contributing significantly to the local economy and supporting ongoing elk management efforts.

What is Forward Facing Sonar Forward Facing Sonar are transducer systems that can show sonar returns from whatever direction an angler is fishing. Some call the whole category "Livescope," having been released first, but each major fish finder brand has developed a version of the technology.

Most people will tell you Forward Facing Sonar is only "live" sonar imaging, like Livescope, Active Target, and MEGA Live – and that will be the focus of this article.

designed for use in water. They both create an image that appears "live," capturing movements in the target area. There are key differences, of course.

Forward Facing Sonar transducers must cover broad sections of the water column at much longer ranges (up to 120 feet) and operate at medium frequencies in the 0.5 to 1.2 MHz range.

So how does this all work on the water? Forward Facing Sonar system has three components:

Transducer – Sends and Receives the sonar signals.

Black Box – Crunches the sonar signals with complicated math and algorithms and sends the data to the display.

Fish Finder – The images are displayed on the screen and can be adjusted with the typical Contrast and Sensitivity settings.

ers, so let's focus on the transducer. Lowrance had one for years to run their Side Scan and Down Scan sonars.

On a Livescope transducer, we can observe three long rectangular sections containing the piezo elements. Google searching for ultrasound transducer images, we find these pictures that look similar.

We can infer that each section of the Livescope transducer also has many piezo elements. Each small piezo crystal sends and receives many sound pulses from a tiny part of the water column. Each section of elements then makes up one-third of the total image.

Think of FFS as hundreds of tiny transducers working together as one larger transducer.

Combine them all (using electronics and math magic in the black box), and you get an image on the fish finder of the water in front of the transducer that appears to be live, much like the squirming baby in its mother's belly at the ultrasound appointment.

What Forward Facing Sonar Can Do

Forward facing sonar gives anglers a live view of the water column in whichever direction the transducer is pointed and oriented

The FFS transducer can be oriented in 3 ways - Forward, Down, and Top Down.

What kinds of things can these sonar views tell us?

Type, size, and shape of cover and structure

Presence of fish

Quantity, Size, and Position of the fish

The most extreme voices on social media will yell at clouds and say – Livescope should be banned!

On the other end, they say only after all our lakes get fished out will FFS be outlawed.

Certain fishing leagues, both pro and amateur might someday offer different classes of competition – One with Forward Sonar and one

#### **Preseason Turkey Scouting Information**

before the season. It's what you do. So, if you're a turkey hunter, why wouldn't you scout before the season? That's a rhetorical question. In fact, it's a question that recently entered my mind as I began to prepare for youth turkey season here in Wisconsin.

You see, this will be my first time

If you're a deer hunter, you scout ever mentoring a youth hunter, gin in most states. Therefore, you and boy, do I want to get him on a bird.

Time your scouting right

Turkeys change their patterns dramatically from winter to spring. This shift from giant winter flocks to smaller, single-digit groups typically happens right before spring turkey seasons bewant to hold off on scouting until about two weeks prior to your turkey hunting season. Scouting before that may lead to poor intel in regards to how turkeys are acting and where they will be during the season.

Use trail cameras to find turkey strut zones

By now, almost every hunter has a trail cam or two. Most hunters will use them during deer season, but only a few will keep them out during the winter and spring. If you're not going to keep them out during the freezing winter months, at least put them back out in time for turkey season. Trail cameras provide all sorts of great information that can help you bag a bird. Set them up in strutting locations to determine when and where you need to be sitting with a shotgun in hand. Strutting zones include open fields, food plots, pastures, ridge tops, and logging roads, to

name a few.

One option that's becoming more popular on today's trail cameras is the ability to shoot in time-lapse mode. This is one of the most underutilized features on trail cameras, and, in my opinion, one of the most useful – for deer and turkey. Set your trail cameras up facing either north or south to prevent sun interference and set them to take a picture every 5-10 minutes during daylight. If there's several dips or rolling hills

Since it's not deer season you're not worried about identifying an individual buck, but rather, just trying to figure if and when turkeys are using a particular area.

Scout from the truck

Not much to explain on this pre-season turkey scouting tactic, but it is an effective way nonetheless. You don't necessarily need a roadside field for this method to be effective. Driving a daily loop on logging roads can be effective as well, as you can spot the toms strutting from a long way off.

Scouting from the truck is also a great way to keep the pressure off the birds. If you don't have any fields you can see from the road on your turkey hunting property, you can still gain valuable information by observing what the turkeys are doing in your area. You can usually get a good idea if they are henned up, with other toms, or alone – all key observations when it comes to deciding what decoys and calls to use. Previous turkey hunting history

have done in the past is crucial to present and future success - after all, history tends to repeat itself. Learning how turkeys interact within the landscape of your hunting property is of utmost importance. Is there a barrier they don't like to cross? A specific roost tree they prefer? An annual strutting grounds? The list of site specific conditions goes on and on, and how well you know them usually plays a big part in your success. Don't just learn the ground you hunt, learn how the turkeys use it. Map it out

Mapping it out builds upon the previous tip of understanding

how turkeys interact within a specific landscape. Map out all the important features and obstacles that may impact your turkey hunt. Fence lines, roost sites, strut using google earth aerial photos. zones, creek bottoms, and feeding areas should all be marked on a

map, so that when one gobbles off in the distance you know exactly where to set up for the kill.

areas will give you a good idea on where you should be hunting throughout the day. Also, when one gobbles unexpectedly you will have a good idea where he is or where he is headed and you can sneak in for the kill.

Boots on the ground

Last, but certainly not least, strap up your boots and get out there. Identifying turkey sign may not be as easy as finding deer sign in the woods, but if you know what you're looking for, certain markers can clue you in on a big strutter's whereabouts. Use the following forms of turkey sign to help you bag a big ol' longbeard this season.

#### **Turkey Wing Feather**

Finding a turkey wing feather in an open forest with mature trees is

Turkey droppings - easily spotted on bare ground and can signify a roosting site if found in high concentrations below a large tree. Turkey droppings are usually two-toned as the brown color tapers into a whitish gray end. Droppings from a gobbler are typically elongated with a J-hook on one end. Droppings from a hen are typically clumped or spiral shaped.

identified in a wooded area where are a good clue.

almost always a sure sign of roost you can see the leaves roughed up. Turkeys will scratch the ground beneath them while they are searching for food.

> Turkey feathers – look for black and white barred wing feathers and tail feathers to locate roost locations. Often a turkey will lose a wing or tail feather from the commotion of flying up or down from a roost tree. If you find several in one area, it's a sign you may want to set up nearby.

Turkey tracks - easily identified Turkey scratchings – most easily by the 3 long, front-facing toes –

#### **Reinstated Trout Stocking**

I'm proud of our continued commitment to both conservation and recreation. and I applaud the collaborative efforts of the WVDNR, USFWS, and West Virginia University that

As part of the agreement, the WVDNR will reinstate stockings in four previously closed waters and restore the stocking frequency of 20 iconic streams during the month of May. Streams returning to the original stocking schedule are:

Pinnacle Creek – Wyoming County

Camp Creek – Mercer County Laurel Creek of Cherry - Greenbrier/Nicholas County North Fork of Cherry - Greenbrier County

"We are thrilled to announce that these waters have returned to the original stocking schedule," said WVDNR Director Brett McMillion. "Thanks to the support and collaboration of Governor Justice, West Virginia anglers can continue to enjoy our world-class trout program."

Following the initial decision to remove these waters from the stocking schedule due to endangered species concerns, Gov. Justice and WVDNR representatives engaged with the USFWS to explore a potential compromise. As a result, the streams will resume
