# **Preseason Deer Scouting**

hunting deer is the pre-season help you find success this hunting scouting.

It's the beginning of unwrapping what the anticipation of the season gives us as a gift.

Which bucks lived? How many deer are moving through your hunting area? What improvements have been made to the habitat?

Avid deer hunters lean into their scouting gear and increase their scouting time more and more every season.

If you just started deer hunting, or are looking for some new tricks for your toolbox, here are some

Some of the most fun about time-tested scouting tactics to season.

> **Top 6 Scouting Tips and Tactics** 1. Current Location Assessment

One of the most important factors is whether you are scouting a property you know, or one that you don't.

Obviously, a new lease or piece of public land is a mystery out of the box, but even a family deer camp can change with changes to the land and hunting pressure.

If you are hunting the same property for another season, look to see if there has been any logging continue to the next page

recently as the new undergrowth should increase deer activity.

Also, try and see what, if anything, changed on the neighboring properties.

Did they put in food plots? Did they also have some logging done? Are there new treestands or hunting blinds that added more pressure on the local deer population?

2. High Impact vs. Low Impact Scouting

One of the most important factors to consider is high-impact scouting versus low-impact scouting.

High impact is making your way through the hunting area



on foot or by vehicle looking for deer signs and not really in a situation where you're concerned if you bump any deer while you're out there.

You know that startling any deer would only be temporary. High-impact scouting is great for looking for rubs, scrapes, game trails, bedding areas, and actual continue to the next page

deer far from the start of the season.

Low impact scouting would certainly be closer to, or actually in, the hunting season.

You're looking for real-time data on where the deer are and what quality of deer could be there for movement of stands and blind locations.

Depending on the results - you could pull an audible on when or where you want to hunt.

3. Locate Food and Cover

Where's the food? Where's the cover?

These two questions you can ask and answer for yourself when scouting deer haven't changed in

a long time.

Using these answers, supported by deer trails, can help you to predict where the deer movement will be and when.

You can start with aerial maps to help narrow your search before you hit a new property, or if it's a property you know, adding a food plot could be the secret ingredient to future success.

Hunting power lines has been a 4. Locate Water Source source of success for many deer hunters.

Why? It's a constant clear cut leaving rich undergrowth for the deer to feed on with safe cover very close by.

Spending a summer evening watching a power line with some binoculars, or looking about 10 yards inside the tree cover could give you some very exciting information about deer activity in that area.

Seeing a creek or river on a map can be a perfect place to start when looking for where to hang your stand or set up your ground blind.

5. Ideal Scouting Locations

Scouting open fields in the evenings might be one of the most effective tactics there is.

After bedding all day most deer will make their way out for dinner just as the sun disappears.

other deer signs that could be 6. Using Trail Cams to Scout there.

Then, all you have to do is set up at the best spot in range for the season.

If you're scouting in mountainous areas, you might not have the benefit of agricultural fields, clear cuts, and food plots.

Deer will eat over 400 species of plants but they still want to bed during the day for protection for the most part.

Most mountain hunters know that a lot of deer, bigger bucks especially, will move to high points of protection in the morning to spend their day looking out for danger.

As the sun begins to go down so will the deer. Scout up high and look for where they are traveling to get low in the evenings.

There has been no bigger gamechanger for scouting in recent years like the trail camera.

Every year they get better and easier to use. Between image quality improving dramatically, most trail cameras also feature

#### New State Record Channel Catfish

SOUTH CHARLESTON, W.Va. — The West Virginia Division of Natural Resources (WVDNR) announced today that an angler from Wayne has caught a state record channel catfish, marking the sixth state record catch of 2024 so far.

"West Virginia's incredible fishing opportunities continue to amaze and attract anglers from near and far and this record-breaking achievement showcases the world-class fishing adventures our state has to offer," said Gov. Jim Justice.

John Tyler Rutherford caught the 43.51-inch, 46.70-pound channel catfish in his father's farm pond in Wayne County on July 21, breaking the length record set in 2022 and the weight record set in 2023. Both records previously were held by Alan Burkett of Moorefield in Hardy County, who caught his fish at South Mill Creek Lake in

Grant County. "I want to congratulate John Tyler Rutherford on his outstanding catch," said WVDNR Director Brett McMillion "This remarkable achievement highlights the

superior quality of West Virginia's fisheries and the dedication of our team in maintaining and enhancing these aquatic resources."

Rutherford reeled in his record catch using worms. WVDNR District Fishery Biologist Jeff Hansbarger and Assistant Fishery Biologist Jake Whalen traveled to the site to measure and weigh the record fish.

In addition to this channel catfish, record tiger trout, redbreast sunfish, bowfin, redear sunfish and black crappie have been caught this year.

# **Live Scoping Bass Debate**

Lately, we've heard a lot of pro anglers say, "I wish we could get ments that the "antis" have lobbed back to real fishing."

Or, alternatively, the slightly less rueful, "I'm just going fishing today."

The part left unsaid is they've allowed themselves to be dragged down — or even demoralized — by the recent overwhelming dominance of anglers using forward-facing sonar (FFS). It's not that you can't use more "traditional" tactics, it's just that it's hard to compete against anglers who rely upon technology.

For the record, I'm still agnostic on whether FFS should be limited in any way. I've heard a great many people who I respect argue it is ruining the sport. I've been jarred by just how much and how quickly it has enabled previously unknown anglers to climb to the top of the leaderboard. Those factors at least force me to consider it may be detrimental to professional fishing. At the same time, I'm not swayed by many of the argu-

It leads me to what I consider the most important questions here: What is "fishing?"

As far as I know there are no stone tablets providing us with guidance on this matter. Beyond any regulations or limitations set by prevailing law, the closest thing we have is the Bassmaster Elite Series rule sheet, which is both vague and hyper-specific. They used to refer to the idea that all fish need to be caught in a conventional and sporting manner. Today, they list specific restrictions (e.g., no umbrella rigs, no live bait, no rods over 10 feet, which is up from the previous limit of 8 feet).



My problem with many of the arguments against FFS is it feels like the advocates of limitation are sometimes throwing crap against the wall and seeing what sticks. For example, they claim it's bad for viewership, bad for conservation and bad for the tackle industry, without any real data continue to the next page

to back that up.

Think about professional football. I love the rocket-fueled nature of the modern passing game, but there was a long period when the forward pass wasn't legal. I'm sure the grind-it-out-on-theground traditionalists of the time were aghast and argued it wasn't "real football," but since then it's become an integral and now-traditional part of the game. Notably, once the forward pass was allowed, that didn't stop the league from continually refining how it should be viewed or regulated as the sport evolved.

Similarly, the NCAA banned the slam dunk from 1967 to 1976. It was allegedly done so at least partially to take away the advantages adhering to players like Kareem Abdul-Jabbar. Today it's not only an accepted part of the game, but also a celebrated drawing factor. I wasn't around when anglers like Dee Thomas and Dave Gliebe first brought flipping to national attention, but I imagine there were naysayers who didn't consider it "real fishing." Someone who was around then correct me if I'm wrong, but I imagine the arguments could have gone

"They're removing the fish from their beds when they're at their most vulnerable, depleting future populations."

al boaters churn up the water and it becomes difficult to position a boat in the rolling waves and properly present my lure through the brush.

Some fish can also be caught in the clear water early and late in the day, but mid-day action is slow as the crappie suspend over deep water. In the stained water areas of a lake, the fish stay shallower and are easier to catch throughout the day.

How To Fish For Crappie In Shallow Water

Minnows are the most popular summertime bait for anglers fishing a tight line off docks or spider rigging in boats. Since a crappie's appetite is voracious during the summer, anglers select larger continue to page 16

minnows (sometimes bigger than 3 inches) for my bait. some prefer using 2/0 and 3/0 hooks because the bigger hook is easier to remove from a crappie and the fish don't swallow it as much as they do a smaller hook.

Jigs are also productive for summertime crappie. Anglers use either a single 1/16-ounce jig for shooting docks or a double rig for vertically jigging above brush piles. The double rig consists of a 1/16-ounce jig spaced 18 inches above a 1/8-ounce jig at the end of my line.

A shallow-water pattern produces best when a summertime shad hatch occurs, but for most of the summer you need to fish deeper water.

How To Fish For Crappie In Deep Water

The shallow pattern consists of dipping minnows with a long pole and slip-bobber system in timber along fence rows and tree lines on the main lake or creek channel. You can catch these fish less than 10 feet deep and sometimes even as shallow as 2 feet. The slip-bobber system allows you to adjust your bobber up or down to find the magic depth in which the

crappie are holding. Use number 2 or 4 hooks and pinch on a couple of number 5 split shots about 2 to 3 inches above the hook. Keeping the weight close to the minnow will restrict its movement to prevent hang-ups in the heavy cover.

The deep-water pattern works best in timber along main lake bluffs and channel swings during the hottest part of summer. The fish will vary in depth from 15 to 25 feet depending on the lake's thermocline. Good luck fishing.

# WV DNR Deer Spotlight Survey

SOUTH CHARLESTON, W.Va management. - The West Virginia Division of Natural Resources (WVDNR) announced today that its personnel will be conducting deer spotlight surveys in all WVDNR districts September.

of different things to focus on. Some archers may be obsessed with their arrows and fletching, while others tune their bow paying attention to even the most minute detail.

What do they both have in common? They want more accuracy.

If you look at everything any archer does in the sport, it all comes down to getting more accurate. Getting your shots in tighter groups, and being able to do so consistently. If you're looking to improve your shooting and get more accurate - use the following archery tips for accuracy and you'll see your overall shots improve in no time.

Relax That Bow Grip Hand

There's one thing I see all the time that's so completely under-



Archery is a great sport, with lots estimated by ninety percent or more of new archers. They're focusing hard on the target, buying the newest and best gear and and trying every brand of arrow possible. Yet their shots are still off.

> They don't relax their grip on the bow! Your non-dominant hand has a huge influence on the accuracy of your shots. Remember this simple, little rule:

> Your bow hand should have as little contact with your bow as is possible.

It should be as if your bow is just barely, gently resting on the top of your bow hand. Start to become more aware of how tightly you're gripping your bow the next few times you shoot, you'll start to see your accuracy improve greatly over time if you keep this in mind.

And while we're at it, regardless of what kind of bow you shoot, you'll need one of these. You can thank me later.

Relax and Breathe

When we become nervous, anxious or even just overly think about things, we as humans naturally do one thing - we hold our breath. The next time you feel

yourself getting tense or nervous try to take note of your body, more than likely you're holding your breath.

This happens all the time: An archer's focusing on the target intently, making sure his form and stance is just right and keeping his draw held as he's been taught. He lets the arrow go, and the show is off it's mark.

He didn't breathe, the whole time he's focusing on all of those different things, he's so in his own head that he forgets to breathe.

Have you ever seen those movies where a sniper takes a deep breath in, let's it go, and then takes the shot? That's exactly why.

I'm not saying that you have to take a deep breath before every shot, just be sure that you're not holding your breath and are at least breathing normally. Most archers, especially newer archers should really read this – it'll help get you in the right mindset when

when it comes to shooting. Practice at the Right Distance

A lot of new, inexperienced archers will ask a fellow archer what distance they should be practicing shots at. There are a few standard answers that keep getting passed around, whether they're right or not.

Many archers are to to practice shots at five yards. And that's what they do. The real answer is to shoot the distance that you're currently capable of shooting accurately.

Don't feel like a dork if you can only hit the target from shorter distances, not only is that perfectly fine for now, but it will improve over time.

Start at three to five yards, even if you're really only shooting good at these distances - keep practicing for now. A weight lifter doesn't start lifting 300 pound barbells, and neither should you. Remember this second simple, little rule:

the target, the more your mistakes are magnified.

Start by shooting where you're comfortable, and then when you're very accurate at that distance - move the target back one yard. Rinse and repeat over time and your shots will be getting consistently more accurate, and at further distances too.

Be Aware of Your Posture

Yeah, you've heard it before: Posture is important to improving your shot. But a lot of archers down play this important fact.

Your posture is hugely important as it directly affects your aim. If you really want to improve your accuracy, start focusing on your posture now.

We probably all know how we're supposed to be standing and the posture that we should have - but are you actually doing it?

Get your bow and get in front of a mirror large enough to be able to see your entire draw. But, don't look in the mirror yet. Draw The further you move away from your bow as you normally would





- don't look at yourself while doing this! Once you have your bow drawn, look at your draw in the mirror. Is your posture 100% cor-

rect?

Do this a few more times, not shot. looking while drawing the bow. Then look to see your posture. Are you noticing a mistake or an area that you need to work on improving?

Wait for it...

Some archers, especially newer ones will release their shot and then immediately look to see where it lands. They can't wait to see their shot, which ironically negatively affects their shot.

After you've released a shot, don't move until your shot has landed! An easy habit to teach yourself is this:

Every time you release a shot, don't move until you hear the arrow hot the target.

This simple trick will increase your accuracy if you make it a practice in archery is how your habit. Especially if you're new feet are planted. This is another

The 10 Second Rule

Many archers, even intermediate archers have a bad habit. They release their shots to quickly. They simply become impatient and don't aim long enough.

Just slowing down and letting yourself have enough time to really focus on the target, breathe, and then release the shot is sometimes one of the hardest things for newer archers to do.

Once you're lined up, focus on the target and aim your shot for at least ten seconds, then release the shot. Do this every time and you'll see your accuracy increase several times over.

thing that people say, but fewer of them do. People tend to get get so hyper-focused on their aim, their draw, their gear - everything but their feet.

The fact is, the wider apart your feet are, the stronger they'll be while you're shooting. Your feet should be at least shoulder length apart. A little trick that helps prevent overlooking your stance is this:

Every time you get set up for a shot, plant your feet first, then focus on your draw, your posture and all the other things that tend to cause us to overlook our footing.
