

60 Fun Fishing Facts

Most fish reproduce by laying eggs, though some fish, such as great white sharks, give birth to live babies called pups.[4]

Lungfish can live out of water for several years. It secretes a mucus cocoon and burrows itself under the unbaked earth. It takes in air with its lung through a built-in breathing tube that leads to the surface. A lungfish has both gills and a lung.[4]

Some fish, such as the great white shark, can raise their body temperature. This helps them hunt for prey in cold water.[5]

The oldest known age for a fish was an Australian lungfish. In 2003, it

was still alive and well at 65 years old.[5]

Fish use a variety of low-pitched sounds to convey messages to each other. They moan, grunt, croak, boom, hiss, whistle, creak, shriek, and wail. They rattle their bones and gnash their teeth. However, fish do not have vocal chords. They use other parts of their bodies to make noises, such as vibrating muscles against their swim bladder.[1]

Fish can form schools containing millions of fish. They use their eyes and something called a lateral line to hold their places in the school. The lateral line is a row of pores running along the fish's sides from head to tail. Special hairs in the pores sense changes in water pressure from the movements of other fish or predators.[5]

Starfish don't have a brain or blood

Starfish are not fish. Neither are iellyfish.[1]

Since a fish's jaw is not attached to its skull, many fishes can shoot their mouths forward like a spring to catch startled prey.[1]

Electric eels and electric rays have enough electricity to kill a horse.[3]

Sharks are the only fish that have evelids.[3]

they have lowered response to stimuli, slowed physical activity, and reduced metabolism but they do not share the same changes in brain waves as humans do when they sleep.[4]

Some fish, such as the herbivorous

fish (grazers), often lack jaw teeth but have tooth-like grinding mills in their throats called pharyngeal teeth.[6]

Most fish have taste buds all over their body.[6]

An estimated one third of male fish in British waters are changing sex due to pollution in human sewage.[7]

Saltwater fish need to drink more water than freshwater fish. Since seawater is saltier than the liquids in a fish's body, water inside the fish is constantly flowing out. If they didn't drink to replace the lost water, saltwater fish would dry up like prunes.[1]

dates back to about 42,000 years ago.[2]

Most fish have little salt in them. Sharks, however, have meat as salty as the ocean they live in.[5] Most brands of lipstick contain fish scales.[5]

colors to camouflage themselves or defend themselves and their territory. Most fish have the best possible eyesight for their habitat and can most certainly see you peering at them in a fish tank. Some fish can see polarized and ultraviolet light.[4]

A fish does not add new scales as it grows, but the scales it has increase in size. In this way, growth rings are formed and the rings reveal the age of a fish.[4]

Fish that have thin fins with a split tail indicate that they move very quickly or may need them to cover great distances. On the other had, fish that live among rocks and reefs near the ocean floor have broad lateral fin and large tails.[5]

A ship has a heavy keel in the lower part to keep it from capsizing. Fish, on the other hand, have the keel on top. If the paired fins stop functioning to keep the fish balanced, the fish turns over because its heaviest part tends to sink, which happens when it dies.[5]

On average, flying fish can glide 160 continue to the next page



feet (50m), but have been known to glide as far as 660 feet (200 m). And they can reach heights up to 19 feet (6m).[5]

An inflated porcupine fish can reach a diameter of up to 35 inches (90 cm). It puffs up by swallowing water and then storing it in its stomach. The stomach increases in size with more water. If the fish is taken out of water, it can inflate in a similar way by swallowing air.[6]

A fish can drown in water. Like humans, fish need oxygen, so if there isn't enough oxygen in the water, they will suffocate.[5]

Although the fangtooth fish is only a few inches long, it has teeth about the size of a human's.[5]

Their teeth are so big that they can't close their mouths completely

The fish in the middle of a school control the school. The fish on the

outside are guided by those in the middle. Only bony fish can swim in highly coordinated groups.[5]

Most fish cannot swim backwards. Those that can are mainly members of one of the eel families.[1]

Fish would suffocate if they tried to chew because chewing would interfere with water passing over their gills.[1]

The biggest fish in the world is the giant whale shark, which can grow to nearly 60 feet, or the length of two school buses. It weighs over 25 tons and eats mainly plankton. It has over 4,000 teeth, though they are only 3 mm long.[4]

The most poisonous fish in the world is the stone fish. Its sting can cause shock, paralysis, and even death if not treated within a few hours.[6]

The word "piranha" is from the

rivers in South America, piranhas have razor-sharp teeth. They typically eat fish, insects, seeds, fruit, and even larger animals such as horses. While there are no proven reports of piranhas killing a person,

they do eat human carcasses.[5]

The fastest fish is the sailfish. It can swim as fast as a car travels on the highway.[4]

Seahorses are poor swimmers and can die of exhaustion in stormy waters

Seahorses are the only fish that swim upright.[1]

The slowest fish is a seahorse. It swims so slowly that a person can barely tell it is moving. The slowest is the Dwarf Seahorse, which takes about one hour to travel five feet. It even looks like it is simply standing up, not swimming.[4] Some fish do not have scales.

Sharks, for example, have rough sandpapery skin instead of scales.[4]

Fish have multiple Christian and pre-Christian overtones. For example, the Greek word for fish is Ichthys, which is an acronym for "Jesus Christ, God's Son, Savior" and was used to mark early Christian tombs and meeting places. Because of their association with fertility, fish have also been linked to Isis and Aphrodite.[5]

In Japan, the fugu, or puffer fish, is a succulent but lethal delicacy. It contains tetrodotoxin, a deadly poi-



son. However, it is so delicious that Japanese gourmets risk their lives to prepare it. To make this high-risk dish, chefs must have a certificate from a special school that teaches preparation of this toxic fish.[6]

Hammerhead sharks can live in

schools of more than 500 sharks. The strongest female swims in the middle. When she is ready to mate, she shakes her head from side to side to signal the other female sharks to move away so she is the center of attention.[1]

Some desert pupfish can live in hot springs that reach temperatures greater than 113° F.[5]

A male emperor angelfish lives together with up to five female mates. If the emperor angelfish dies, one of the females turns into a male fish and becomes the leader of the group.[5]

Mudskippers are also able to jump 2 feet in the air

The mudskipper is a fish that spends most of its time out of water and can "walk" on its fins. It carries a portable water supply in its gill chambers when it leaves the water. It can also breathe through the pores of its wet skin.[5]


There are approximately 32,000 different kinds of fish in the world today, which is more than all the other kinds of vertebrates combined. Scientists are discovering new species all the time.[4]


Anableps, four-eyed fish, can see above and below water at the same time.[4]

Sometimes tornadoes pick up fish while traveling over water and carry them over land, where the fish rain down. These "fish showers" have been happening for thousands of years. Roman writer Pliny the Younger describes this phenomenon in the 1st century A.D.[5]

Male anglerfish are much smaller than the female. While the female can reach up to 24 inches long, the males barely reach 1.6 inches long and live as parasites on their mates. They stay together for life. As the male ages, he gets smaller and smaller. The female anglerfish's light is always "on." [3]

Scientists have explored only 1% of the ocean depths. They believe millions of new kinds of animals



Humans have been amazed for centuries that salmon, after journeying across the ocean, can find the river where they were born. In the Yukon River in Alaska and in Canada, cer-


tain tagged Chinook salmon covered nearly 2,000 miles in 60 days. Salmon also have adapted to live in a variety of aquatic environments, including rivers, lakes, estuaries, coral reefs, and the open sea.

Fish were the first vertebrates with bony skeletons to appear on Earth. Unlike today's fish, early fish had no scales, fins, or jawbone, but they did have a dorsal fin.

Hagfish are some of the slimiest animals on earth. An Atlantic hagfish can make enough slime in one minute to fill a bucket.] Unlike bony fish, sharks and rays do not have swim bladders. They have to swim all the time, even when they are sleeping. Otherwise, they will sink to the bottom of the ocean.

A seahorse can move each of its eyes separately. One eye can look forward while the other looks backward. Seahorses can also change their color to match their surroundings.



salmon are 10 fish). The term "fishes" is used when referring to more than one species (e.g., 10 salmon, 3 trout, and 1 angel fish are 14 fishes).

Unlike most other fish, the ocean sunfish does not have a tail. A female sunfish can lay 300 million eggs each year. Each egg is smaller than the period at the end of this sentence.

Lampreys are jawless and have a round sucker-like mouth

Lampreys and hagfish are the most primitive form of fish still living

today.

Most types of seahorses pair for life. Female seahorses lay their eggs inside a pouch on the male seahorse's belly. When the babies are ready to hatch, the male holds onto a piece of seaweed with his tail and rocks back and forth until the babies pop out of his pouch.

The freshwater Pygmy and Luzon gobies of the Philippines, the saltwater Marshal Islands goby, and the tiny rice fish from Thailand all reach a maximum length of 1/2", roughly the size of a grain of rice.

Black Bear Harvest

SOUTH CHARLESTON, W.Va. – West Virginia hunters harvested 3,012 black bears during the combined 2016 archery, crossbow and firearms seasons, according to Colin Carpenter, Black Bear Project leader for the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources.

The preliminary black bear harvest data for the combined 2016 seasons were 6 percent lower than the record set in 2015. The harvest is the second highest bear kill recorded and is the second time the harvest has topped 3,000.

"The mast index for all oak species in 2016 increased significantly over 2015 and was above the long-term average," said Carpenter. "Historically, an abundance of oak mast makes bears harder to target for archery hunters. Conversely, increased oak mast typically means a higher December firearms harvest because many bears delay entering their dens due to the abundance of food."

Carpenter added, "In the 2016 Mast Survey and Hunting Outlook, we predicted a decreased archery harvest and a similar-to-slightly greater December firearms harvest over the levels observed in 2015. Our prediction held true for the archery season, but did not hold up in the December season."

"Overall, the 2016 harvest de-

clined during the archery, buckgun and December seasons over the levels recorded in 2015. However, those decreases were partially offset by very successful early gun seasons in September and October. Hunters killed 1,012 bears during the first segment of the 2016 archery season (Sept. 24 – Nov. 19). They took 584 bears with vertical bows and 428 with crossbows. The top five counties were Randolph (82), Fayette (74), Nicholas (60), Greenbrier (55) and Preston (52). Firearms hunters harvested 2,000 bears during 2016. Hunters took 883 bears in September and October, 349 during the concurrent buck-gun bear season, and 768 during the traditional December season. The top five counties were Pendleton (177), Randolph (167), Pocahontas (161), Nicholas (153) and Hardy (133).



2016 Total Deer Harvest

SOUTH CHARLESTON, W.Va. – Preliminary counts indicate West Virginia hunters harvested 112,384 white-tailed deer during the recently completed bucks firearms, antlerless, muzzleloader, archery, crossbow, and youth/Class Q/Class XS deer seasons, according to Paul Johansen, chief of the Division of Natural Resources (DNR) Wildlife Resources Section. This year's total harvest was 19 percent below the 2015 deer harvest of 138,493 and 15 percent below the five-year average of 132,466.

A breakdown of the combined 2016 deer seasons reveals 46,071 bucks harvested during the traditional buck firearm season, 32,508 antlerless deer taken during all ant-

lerless firearm hunting opportunities, 28,808 deer harvested by bows and crossbows, and 4,997 deer taken by muzzleloader hunters.

Antlerless Deer Season

The 2016 antlerless deer season harvest, which includes the youth/ Class Q/Class XS deer season, was 18 percent less than in 2015 and 26.5 percent below the five-year average of 44,239. "It is important to note that the antlerless harvest is the key component to any deer management strategy, as it controls the future deer population," said Johansen. Hunters are reminded that on March 13 and 14, 2017, the DNR will hold 12 public meetings across the state to gather comments on proposed fall 2017 antlerless deer hunting seasons in each of the 21 Country Market



of 4,997 was 3 percent below the 2015 harvest of 5,178, and 21 percent below the five-year average of 6,344. The top 10 counties are Randolph (243), Nicholas (232), Preston (217), Upshur (185), Lewis (168), Jackson (158), Braxton (157), Mason (153), Wood (141), and Webster (139).

Archery and Crossbow Deer Season

The bow and crossbow hunter's take of 28,808 deer was 11 percent less than the 2015 archery season harvest of 32,540, and four percent above the five-year average archery season harvest of 27,596. Archery harvests are inversely correlated to hard mast crops. The below-average acorn crop in 2015, followed by a better acorn crop in 2016, likely contributed to the lower 2016 harvest; however, the proportion of the harvest taken using a crossbow increased in 2016 over that recorded in 2015. The 2016 top 10 counties are: Preston (1,365), Randolph (975), Wood (945), Kanawha (921), Upshur (867), Wyoming (867), Mason (791), Jackson (785),

The Best Day To **Catch A Trophy Bass**

By Tom Redington

Bass are fat and egg-laden in the prespawn, making it prime trophyhunting season. Of course, you already knew that. As for the best prespawn day to go for a big one, our opinions probably differ. Most folks would target the day that a front passes, or during a long spring warming trend. Me? I've caught many of my truly largest bass in "dreaded" post-frontal conditions.

Fishing on a daily basis, first as a guide on Lake Fork and now as a pro, I've been able to watch the bass bite ebb and flow each spring. Fronts roll through about every five to seven days. It becomes a fairly predictable cycle of fishcontinue to the next page

Yamaha Can-Am ing getting good, then the weather changing and things slowing down. Over and over it goes, until a prolonged warming trend kicks off the spawn.

Warm and stable weather usually results in consistently good fishing. The pattern stays the same for a few days, and once you figure it out, you can catch fish reliably. The day a cold front arrives is the favorite day of most anglers. The front really turns on the bass, and this is the day to catch big numbers and some good fish too.

As the front passes, conditions turn nasty, the bite slows and fairweather fishermen stay home. Air temps drop quickly with a cold front, and the pressure changes, but water temps aren't affected at first. The following day, water temps plummet, and north winds thrash the lake.

In my experience, the crashing water temps seem to urge the biggest bass to feed. Although fish are less aggressive, they're often grouped up in the thickest available cover or the closest deeper water near any hot spots that you found during the front. For example, if bass were roaming a shallow flat before the front, check nearby matted grass, brush piles, points or creek channels after the front.

Once I get a bite on a post-frontal day, I assume there is a school in the area. Even though it's typically

shallow fishing, I think of it more like offshore ledge fishing. Time to drop the Power-Poles and go to work. Bass on Lake Fork often drop back to creek-channel bends. While they might have been all across a 200-yard-long flat before the front, they will hang around a couple specific stumps on a bend afterward. Many times, I'd have guide customers cast jigs to the same stumps for 30 to 45 minutes. The fishing is painstakingly slow, but when one bites, you better get the net.

So the moral of the story is to go out and catch a bunch of fish when

the front passes. But for a fish of a lifetime, or your biggest five-bass limit ever, meticulously work key spots the day after the front.

What about my least favorite days? Everyone's aware that the second day after a front just stinks. Two cold nights, bluebird skies and no wind take their toll. We all hate that day. But the fair-weather fishermen return as soon as the temps rise again. Those first couple warm days feel good to us anglers, but I find the fishing just fair. They are what I call "table setters." That is, they set things up for good fishing once the next front starts to approach, and the whole process begins again.

All your golfing buddies call in sick on the nice days, surely causing their bosses to raise their eyebrows. If you play hooky on the nasty post-frontal days, you might catch a lunker ... plus your boss won't suspect a thing.



Trout Basics

Trout is a term used for several types of fish that are a part of one of three genera: oncorhyunchus, salmo or salvelinus. They live in freshwater, but some trout do spend time out in the ocean and return to freshwater to spawn, just like salmon, which trout are closely related to. Several common types of trout are brown trout, lake trout, rainbow trout and steelhead. A trout's diet usually consist of other fish and aquatic invertebrates. When a trout reaches over 12 inches they'll usually only feed on smaller fish. Trout are a very popular game fish and many state wildlife agencies stock lakes, ponds and streams with trout for anglers to catch.

You can locate trout in lakes and streams with cool water. The ideal temperature range is 50 to 60 degrees. Juvenile trout can also be known as fry, troutlet and troutling. They tend to mature around 2 to 3 years of age. The lifespan on trout depends on the species. For example, a rainbow trout can live continue to the next page

The large trout will most likely be in these pools during dawn and dusk. Choose Your Lures Wisely - It's really important to pick the right lures. 
